“Insofar as possible, a person to be baptized is to be given a sponsor who assists an adult in Christian initiation or together with the parents presents an infant for baptism. A sponsor helps the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent in it.” (Canon 872, Code of Canon Law)

The role of a sponsor is such an important one that the Catholic Church has specific requirements for those asked to fulfill it. The following statements come from the requirements for sponsors and godparents as set down in the Code of Canon Law of the Catholic Church. The relevant canonical requirements are listed on the back of this form.

SPONSOR/GODPARENT
CODE OF CANON LAW OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Can.872 *Insofar as possible, a person to be baptized is to be given a sponsor who assists an adult in Christian initiation or together with the parents presents an infant for baptism. A sponsor also helps the baptized person to lead a Christian life in keeping with baptism and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent in it.*

Can.873 *There is to be only one male sponsor or one female sponsor or one of each.*

Can.874 §1. *To be permitted to take on the function of sponsor a person must:*

- *Be designated by the one to be baptized, by the parents or the person who takes their place, or in their absence by the pastor or minister and have the aptitude and intention of fulfilling this function;*
- *Have completed the sixteenth year of age, unless the diocesan bishop has established another age, or the pastor or minister has granted an exception for a just cause;*
- *Be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on;*
- *Not be bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared;*
- *Not be the father or mother of the one to be baptized.*

§2. *A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community is not to participate except together with a Catholic sponsor and then only as a witness of the baptism.*

PADRINO/MADRINA

CÓDIGO DE DERECHO CANÓNICO DE LA IGLESIA CATÓLICA

Can.872 *En la medida de lo posible, a la persona que va a ser bautizada se le asignará un padrino o madrina, que asiste al adulto en la iniciación cristiana o, junto con los padres, hace la presentación del niño para el bautismo. El padrino ayudará también al bautizado a llevar una vida cristiana conforme al bautismo y a cumplir fielmente las obligaciones inherentes al mismo.*

Can.873 *Debe haber un solo padrino o una sola madrina, o uno de cada uno.*

Cán.874 §1. *Para poder asumir la función de padrino o madrina, una persona debe:*

- *Ser designado por el que va a ser bautizado, por los padres o por la persona que haga sus veces, o en su defecto por el párroco o ministro y tener aptitud e intención de cumplir esta función;*
- *Haber cumplido los dieciséis años de edad, a no ser que el Obispo diocesano haya establecido otra edad, o el párroco o ministro haya concedido una excepción por justa causa;*
- *Ser católico confirmado y haber recibido ya el santísimo sacramento de la Eucaristía y llevar una vida de fe acorde con la función que se va a asumir;*
- *No estar sujeto a ninguna pena canónica legítimamente impuesta o declarada;*
- *No ser padre o madre del que va a ser bautizado.*

§2. *El bautizado que pertenece a una comunidad eclesial no católica no debe participar sino junto con un padrino católico y entonces sólo como testigo del bautismo.*
