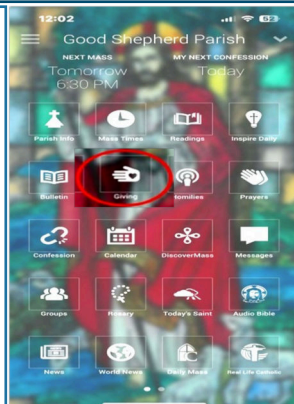

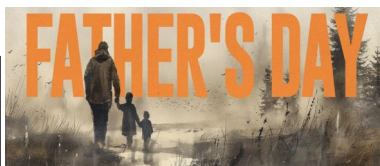

Ordination to the Priesthood

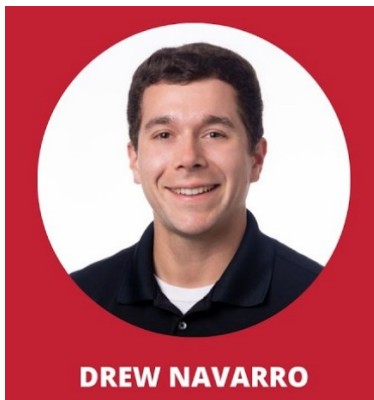

If you come to Mass at Good Shepherd every weekend, we ask you to please consider registering in our family/member database. Registration is a sign of one's commitment and responsibility to the parish. Knowing how many Catholic families and individuals attend our services helps us to plan for everyone's needs. Registration is **required for participation** in parish programs and receiving Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation) and the Sacrament of Marriage.

What is **Active Membership**?

1) Registration in the parish for a sufficient period of time and use of the envelope or EFT system in support of the parish; 2) Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days; and 3) Volunteer and participate in Parish activities with time, talent, and treasure as means permit.

Please note: The Facilities and Services of Good Shepherd Parish are available to active members only.

Sick, Homebound, Hospitalized: Please notify the Parish Office when someone is ill and unable to attend Mass for any significant length of time and would like to receive Holy Communion.
