Manufacture Site for PAP Free Drug

- <https://www.needymeds.org>
 - No login required
- Copay Card Options
 - Commercially Insured patients **MUST** use a copay card if available
- Free Drug Options
 - Programs are directly through the manufacturer mostly reserved for Medicare Part D patients
 - If commercially insured patient's insurance denies the medication, all levels of appeals must be completed prior to attempting for assistance.

Not all manufacturers will assist with Free Drug for commercially insurance patients.

Tips And Tricks

- Quicker responses from manufacturers for Free Drug Programs
 - Forms must be filled out completely.
 - Provider signatures must be a wet signature.
 - Best practices include:
 - Send the Healthcare Provider (HCP) portion of application along with the patient portion together to avoid delays.
 - Insurance cards must be included on application.
 - Household size and income must be included on patient portion of application.
