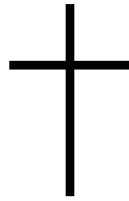

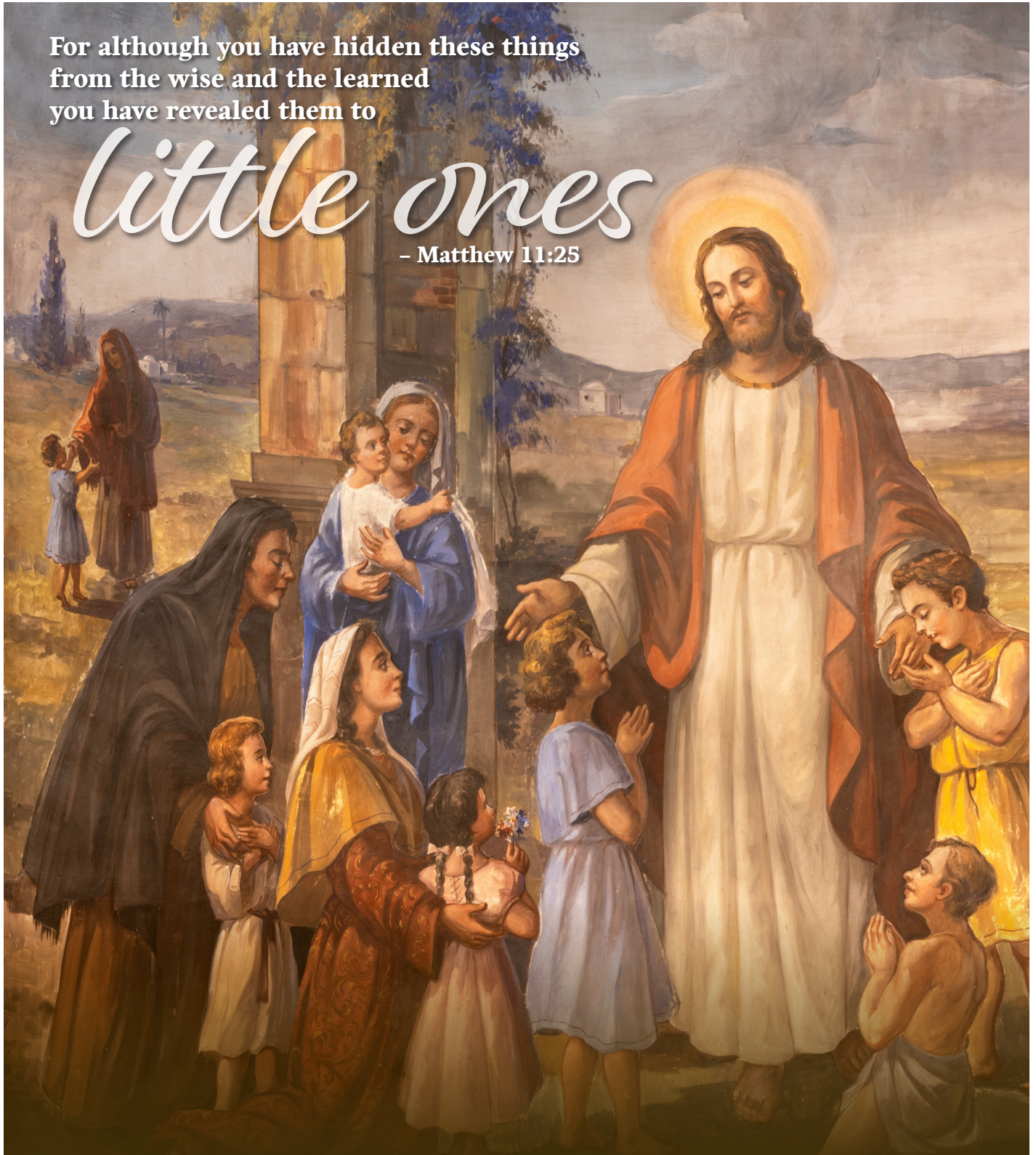

Welcome

"Jesus Loves me, this I know." *Simple Faith, Lasting Peace*

Dear Friends:

One of the most surprising things Jesus says in this Sunday's Gospel is this: "I give praise to you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for although you have hidden these things from the wise and the learned, you have revealed them to little ones."

At first, that sounds strange.

The Church has always valued learning. We built schools, universities, libraries, and seminaries. Some of the greatest minds in history have been saints. So what does Jesus mean? He means that the deepest truths are often the simplest.

A child can understand that God is our Father.

A child can understand that Jesus loves us.

A child can understand that we should love God and love our neighbor.

The difficulty is not understanding these truths. The difficulty is living them.

As we grow older, we sometimes complicate what God has made simple. We become experts at explaining why we do not have time to pray, why forgiveness is difficult, or why holiness can wait until tomorrow.

Yet Jesus points us back to the simplicity of a child.

Many years ago, the great theologian Karl Barth was asked to summarize the most profound insight of his long career. Those listening expected a complex answer. Instead, he replied: "Jesus loves me, this I know." There is more wisdom in that simple statement than in many volumes of theology.

Jesus then makes an even more remarkable claim. He tells us that whoever knows Him knows the Father. If we want to know what God is like, we need only look at Christ. Look at how He treats sinners. Look at how He welcomes children. Look at how He forgives His enemies. Look at how He gives His life on the Cross. Jesus is not merely someone who teaches us about God. He reveals God.

Finally, Jesus extends one of the most comforting invitations in all of Scripture: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." Many people today carry heavy burdens: anxiety, grief, family struggles, financial worries, health concerns, and uncertainty about the future.

Jesus does not promise a life without crosses. He does promise that we do not carry them alone.

The saints discovered that life becomes lighter when we stop trying to control everything ourselves and instead place everything into the hands of Christ. The more we trust Him, the lighter our burden becomes.

Perhaps that is the lesson of this Sunday's Gospel: the secret of holiness is not mastering complicated ideas. It is becoming childlike enough to trust God, simple enough to follow Christ, and humble enough to place our burdens into His hands.

In the end, the saints are not those who knew the most. They are those who trusted the most.

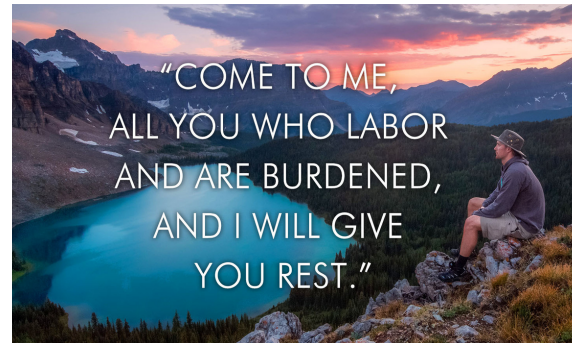

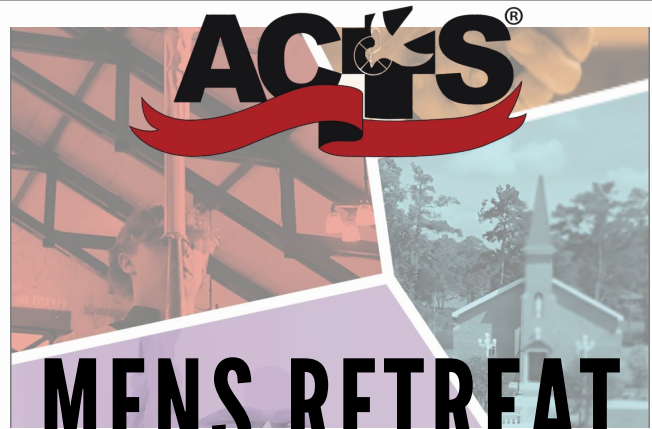

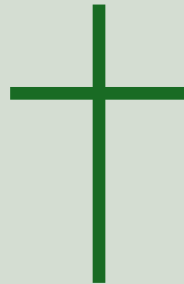
