She Would Not Give Up on Her Daughter

Bring them to Jesus!

Dear Friends:

Last week, I wrote about Peter stepping out of the boat.

For a few remarkable moments, he walked on water because he kept his eyes fixed on Jesus. But when he focused on the wind and the waves, he began to sink. The lesson was simple: the more we focus on our fears, the larger they become. The more we focus on Christ, the more we discover that He is greater than every storm.

This Sunday's Gospel gives us another lesson in faith—this time from someone we might least expect. Not from one of the Apostles. Not from one of the Jewish religious leaders. But from a Gentile mother whose daughter was suffering terribly.

She comes to Jesus with one request: "Lord, help me."

At first, Jesus seems silent. Then His words seem surprisingly harsh. Yet she refuses to walk away. She continues to trust. She continues to ask. She continues to hope.

And Jesus responds with words He spoke to very few people in the Gospels: **"O woman, great is your faith!"**

What made her faith so great?

She refused to believe that silence meant rejection. She refused to believe that a delay meant God did not care. She loved her daughter too much to give up, and she trusted Jesus too much to stop asking.

I think every parent—and every grandparent—can understand that kind of faith.

Many of you pray every day for your children or grandchildren. Some have drifted from the Church. Some carry heavy burdens. Some are making choices that keep you awake at night. You would do almost anything to help them.

This remarkable woman reminds us what to do when we can no longer fix the problem ourselves: bring them to Jesus, and never stop.

Last week, Peter taught us to keep our eyes on Christ in the middle of the storm. This week, a mother's persistent faith teaches us never to stop trusting Him with the people we love most.

As our parish continues welcoming new men and women into OCIA and accompanying others who are returning to the Church, may we become a community that never gives up on anyone. Christ certainly never gives up on us.

Whatever burden you carry this week, keep bringing it—and the people you love—to Jesus.

He always hears the prayer of a trusting heart.

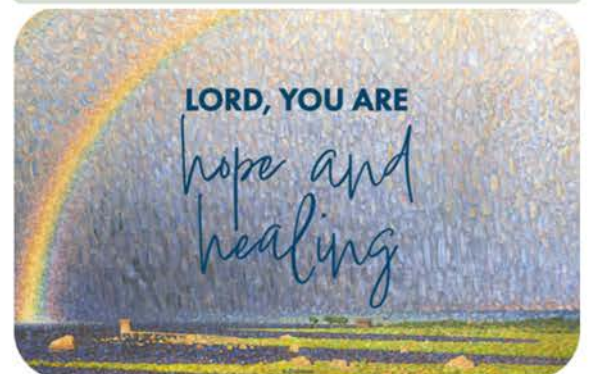

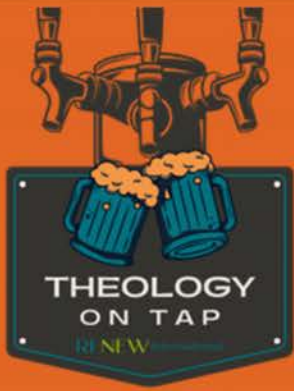

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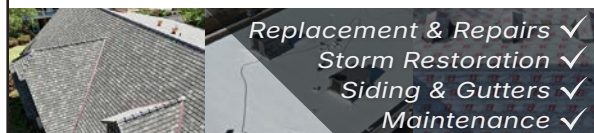


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
