Who Do You Say That I Am? — Part I

*When Faith
Becomes Personal*

Dear Friends:

There are questions we can answer without thinking very much: Where are you from? What do you do? What are you having for dinner? And then there are questions that can change a life.

Jesus asks one of those questions in this Sunday's Gospel.

He begins rather safely: "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?"

The disciples have plenty of answers. John the Baptist. Elijah. Jeremiah. One of the prophets.

In other words: *Here is what everybody else is saying about you.*

But Jesus is not particularly interested in public opinion. He makes the question personal: "**But who do you say that I am?**" Peter answers: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

That answer changes everything.

Jesus gives Simon a new name: Peter—Rock. "Upon this rock I will build my Church." Then He promises that the gates of hell will not prevail against it, and He gives Peter "the keys to the Kingdom of heaven."

Those keys are important.

Our first reading gives us the background. In ancient Israel, the king appointed a steward who exercised authority in the royal household. Isaiah describes that office by saying that the "key of the House of David" would be placed upon Eliakim's shoulder: "when he opens, no one shall shut; when he shuts, no one shall open."

Centuries later, Jesus deliberately uses that same imagery. The Son of David, the true King, establishes His Kingdom and entrusts Peter with the keys. Here, in seed, we see what Catholics believe about the office of Peter and his successors. Christ does not abandon His Church to figure everything out for herself. He gives her shepherds, authority, and a visible rock upon which she can stand.

And what is remarkable is the man Jesus chooses. Peter is hardly "rock-like" at first. He speaks before thinking. He misunderstands Jesus. He will deny Him three times. Yet Christ sees not merely what Peter is, but what Peter can become through grace. After Pentecost, this impulsive fisherman will indeed become a rock for the early Church.

There is hope for all of us in that.

Jesus does not wait until we are perfect before He calls us. He calls us, gives us grace, and then begins making us into the people He created us to be.

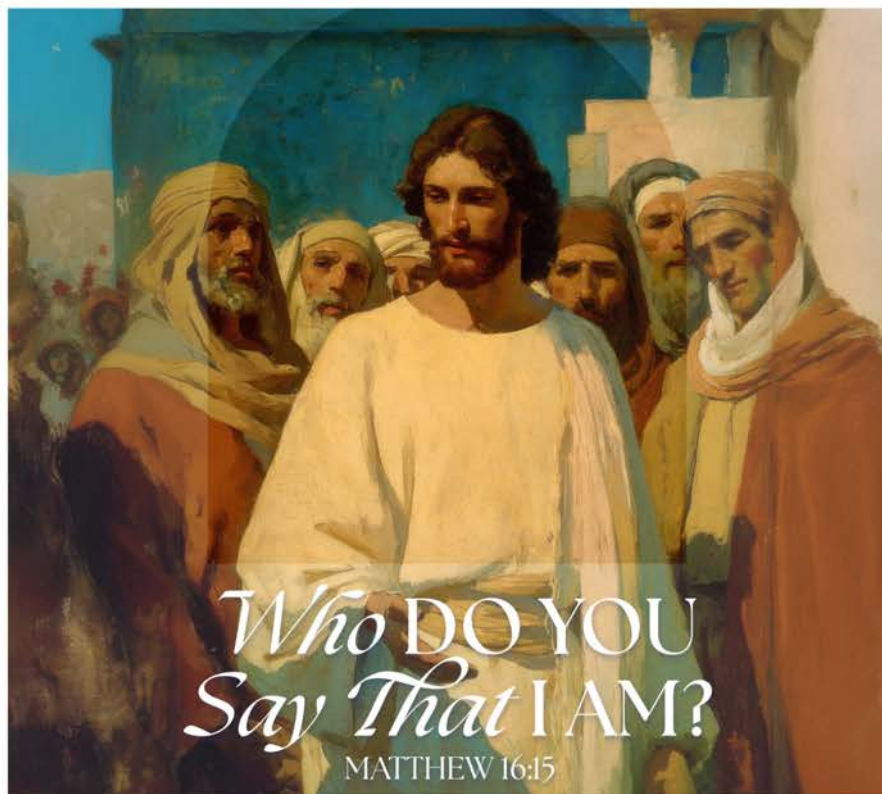
But it begins with Peter's question—and ours, because eventually every Christian must stand before Jesus personally and answer: "**Who do you say that I am?**"

And if our answer really is, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God," then another question follows:

What difference does that make in the way I live?

Peter is about to discover that answering that second question is considerably harder. We'll see why next Sunday.

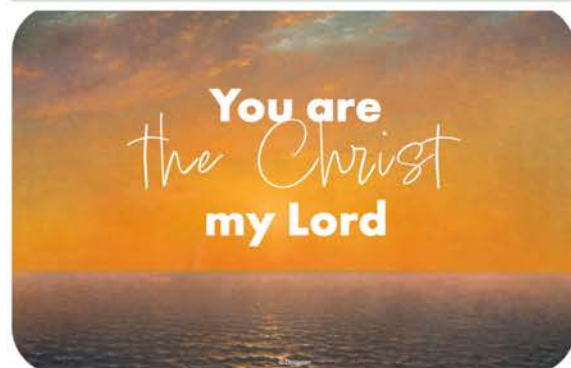

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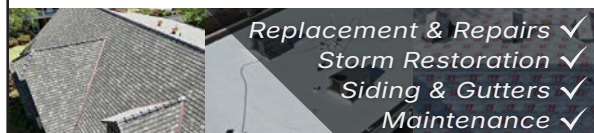


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
