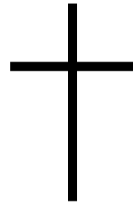


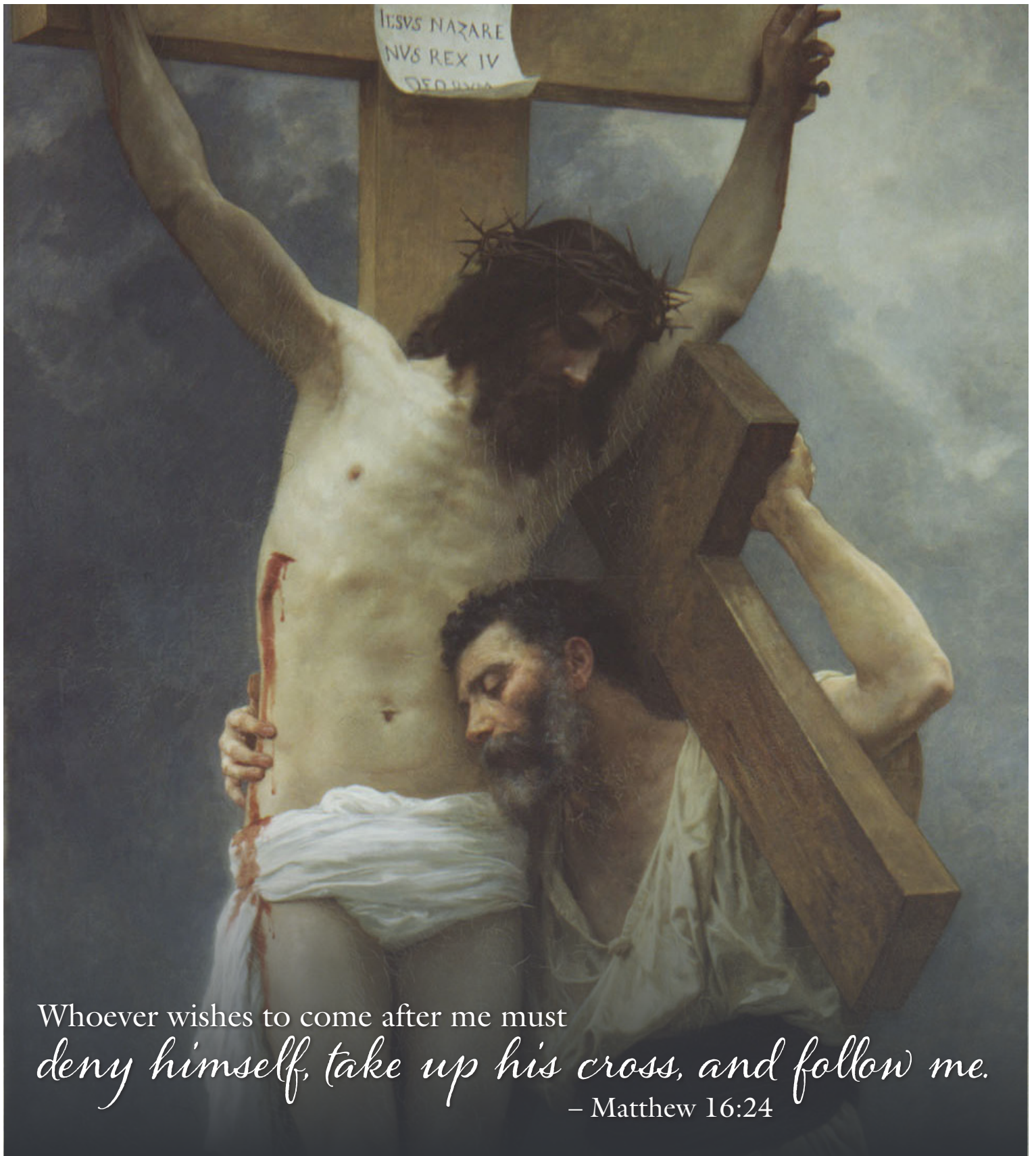

When Jesus Doesn't Follow Our Plan — Part II

Beyond Our Plans

Dear Friends:

Last Sunday Peter had perhaps the greatest moment of his life. Jesus asked, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter answered beautifully: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus called him blessed, gave him a new name (Peter, the Rock) and entrusted him with the keys to the Kingdom of heaven. You would think Peter was doing pretty well.

Then we turn the page.

Jesus begins explaining that He must go to Jerusalem, suffer greatly, be killed, and on the third day be raised. Peter doesn't like the sound of that at all. He takes Jesus aside and begins to rebuke Him: "God forbid, Lord! No such thing shall ever happen to you." And Jesus responds with some of the strongest words He ever speaks to one of His disciples: "Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me."

What happened?

Peter got the identity of Jesus right—but he still had the mission of Jesus wrong.

He believed Jesus was the Messiah. He simply had his own idea of what the Messiah ought to do. And there is the danger for every one of us. We can believe in Jesus and still spend a great deal of our lives trying to tell Jesus how He ought to be Jesus. We are quite happy to have a Savior who comforts us, forgives us, strengthens us and answers our prayers. But then comes the Cross.

Forgive the person who hurt you.

Change something in your life that you know is sinful. Remain faithful when doing so costs you something. Trust God when your prayer seems unanswered. Accept a cross you never asked for and would gladly give back.

Suddenly Peter's words can become ours: *God forbid, Lord! Surely this cannot be part of the plan.*

But Christianity without the Cross is not Christianity. Jesus does not tell Peter that suffering is good in itself. Nor does He tell us to go looking for suffering. He tells us something far more challenging: When fidelity to God leads us to the Cross, we must not abandon Him there. "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." Notice that Jesus says **his cross**.

My cross may not be yours. It may be illness, disappointment, loneliness, caring for someone who needs us, a family difficulty, a temptation that must be resisted day after day, or simply the thousand little sacrifices required to remain faithful to Christ.

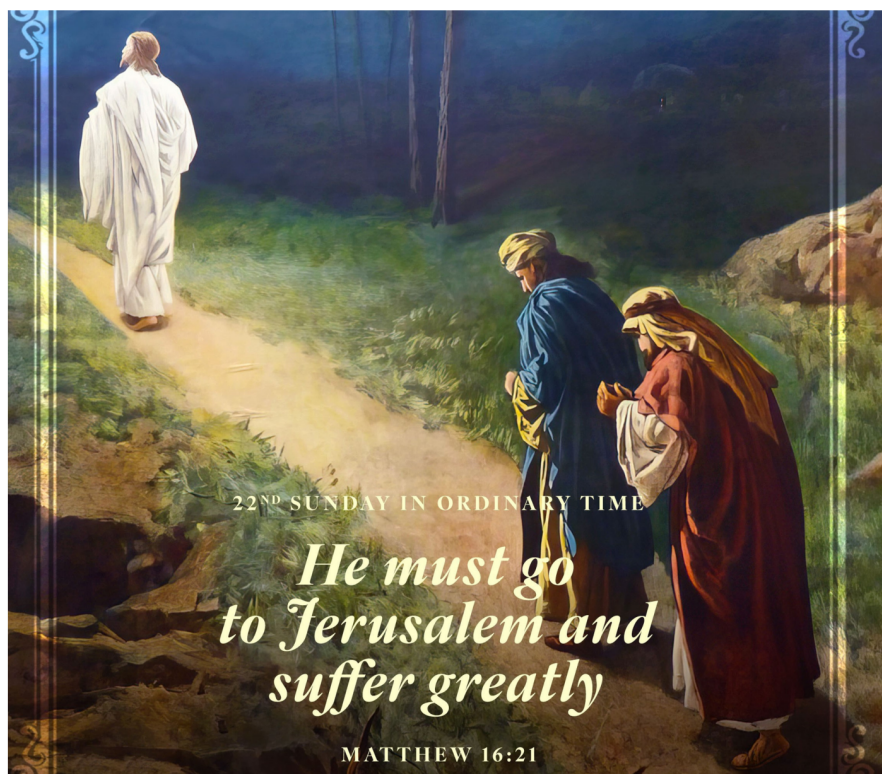
Peter will eventually learn this.

The man who once told Jesus to avoid the Cross will one day embrace his own. Tradition tells us that Peter himself was crucified in Rome. The fisherman who once recoiled from suffering eventually gave his life for the One he had confessed as "the Christ, the Son of the living God." That is what grace can do.

Last Sunday Jesus asked us: **"Who do you say that I am?"** This Sunday He asks the question that necessarily follows: *If I really am your Lord, will you follow Me even when the road leads somewhere you would rather not go?*

It is relatively easy to confess Christ when He fits our plans. Discipleship begins when we allow Christ to change them.

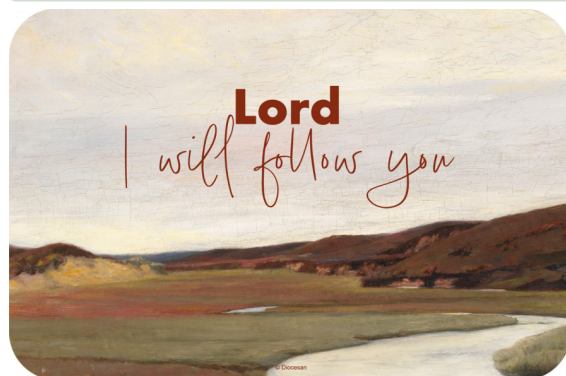
