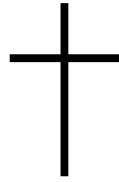

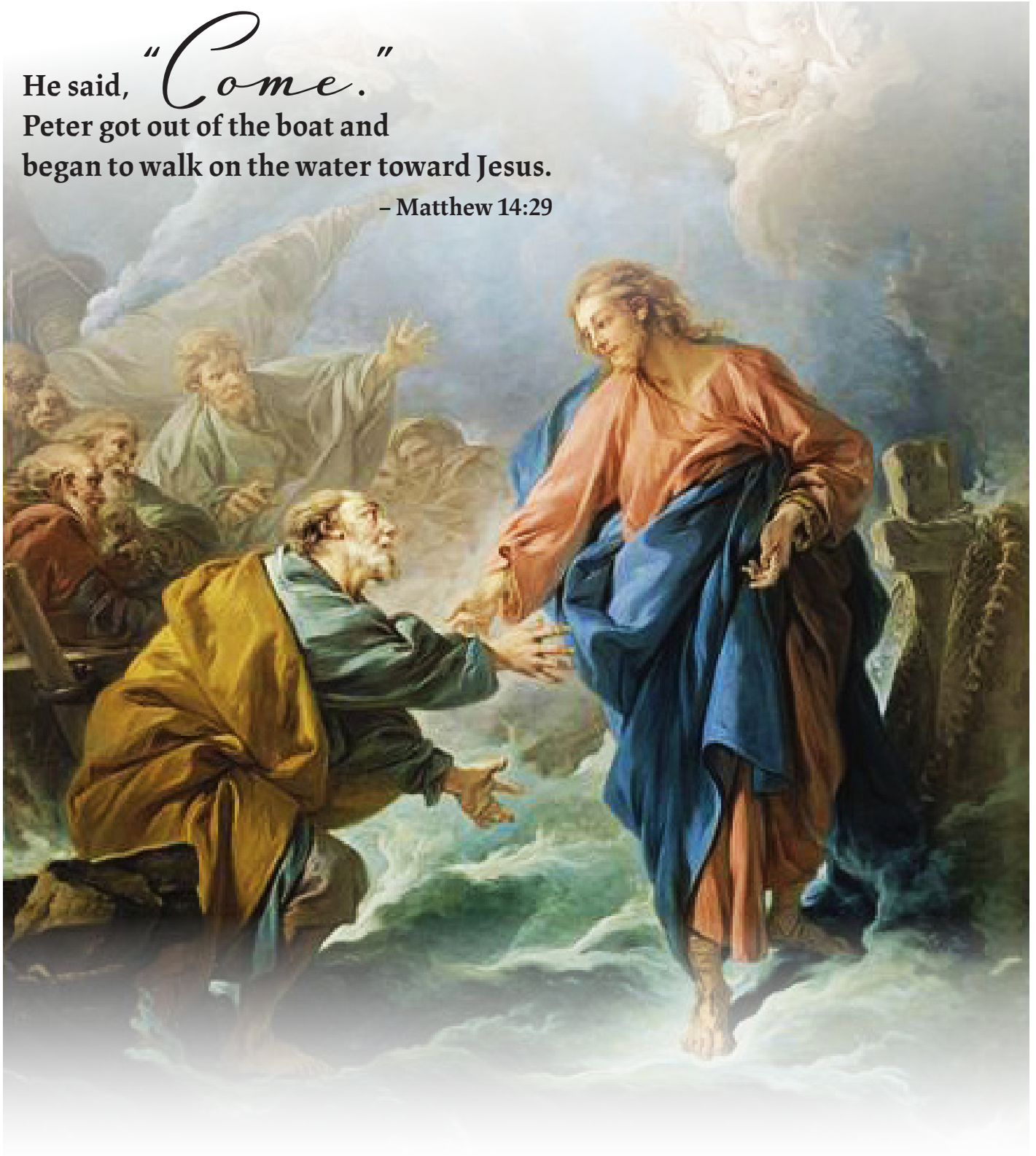

## He Will Never Let Go of the Hand That Reaches Out to Him

*Eyes Fixed on Christ!*

Dear Friends:

Every one of us knows what it feels like to be caught in a storm.

For some, the storm is getting children ready for a new school year while balancing work, marriage, and family life. For others, it is caring for aging parents, worrying about finances, facing a health diagnosis, or wondering what the future holds. Sometimes the storm is hidden from everyone else: anxiety, loneliness, discouragement, or a faith that feels stretched thin.

The Gospel this Sunday reminds us that faith is not the absence of storms. **It is learning where to keep our eyes while the storm is raging.**

Peter had enough faith to step out of the boat—but only because Jesus invited him. He did not act on impulse or emotion. He trusted the Lord's command. And for a few remarkable moments, Peter did the impossible: he walked on water.

Then St. Matthew tells us that “when he saw how strong the wind was he became frightened.” Peter shifted his gaze from Jesus to the waves. The storm around him suddenly became the focus of his attention. Fear replaced trust, and he began to sink.

Isn't that often our story?

We spend hours scrolling through headlines, social media, and endless opinions. We replay tomorrow's worries before tomorrow ever arrives. Before long, the waves seem bigger than the One who created the sea.

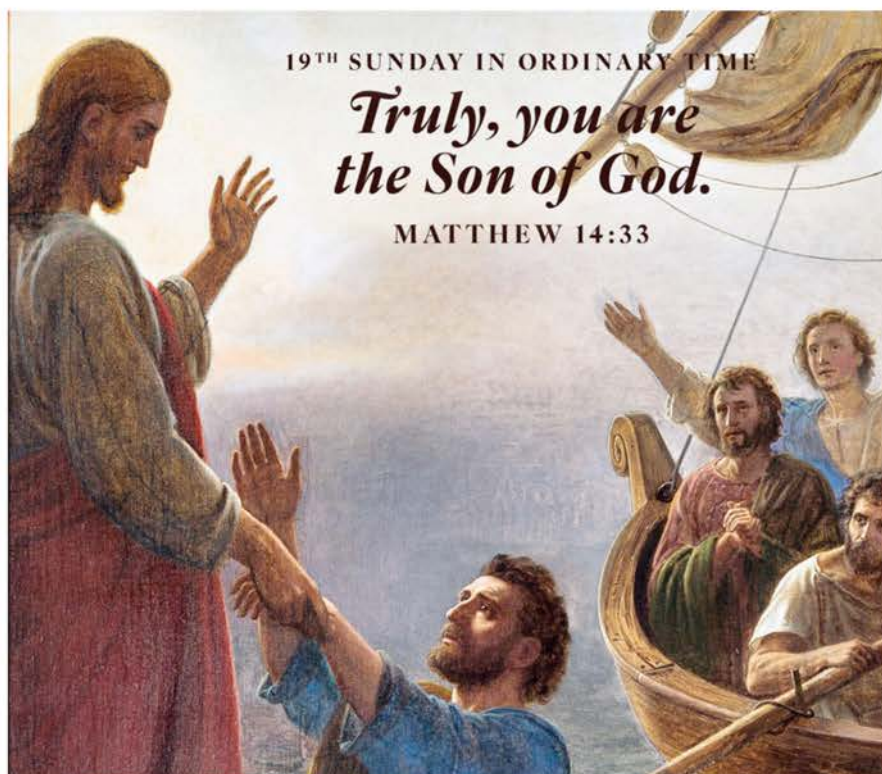
**The more we stare at our problems, the larger they seem. But when our attention returns to Christ—His presence, His promises, and His providence—the storm loses its power over us.**

Notice something else. The moment Peter cried out, “Lord, save me!” Jesus did not hesitate. St. Matthew tells us that **immediately** Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him. Peter's faith faltered, but Jesus' grasp did not.

In just two days, on Tuesday, August 11, our parish will begin a **new year of OCIA**. Men and women from many different backgrounds will take a courageous step. Some have never been baptized. Some come from other Christian traditions. Some are Catholics returning home after many years away. Like Peter, they are stepping out of the boat—not because they have every answer, but because Jesus is calling them. There is always room for one more.

Whatever storm you are facing today, hear again the words Jesus first spoke to His frightened disciples: “Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid.” Keep your eyes on Him. He is greater than every wave, stronger than every wind, and He will never let go of the hand that reaches out to Him.

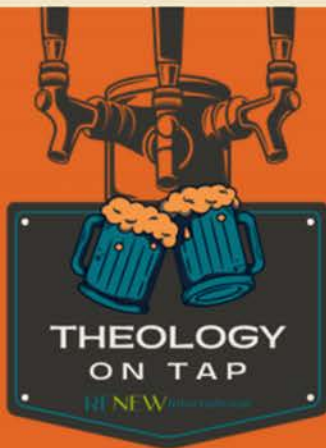

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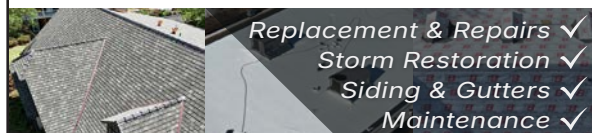

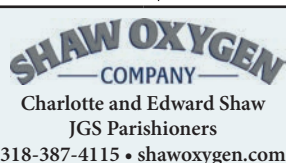
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
