Open Both Eyes

Receiving and Giving Mercy

Dear Friends:

There are two facts Jesus asks us to hold together in this Sunday's Gospel.

Fact #1: God has forgiven us.

We believe that Jesus Christ gave His life for us on the Cross. He took upon Himself the burden of our sins and reconciled us to the Father. We come to Mass because we believe that. We approach the altar because we believe that. Every time we go to Confession, we experience it personally. We have received mercy beyond anything we could ever deserve.

Then there is **Fact #2:** Somebody has hurt us.

Maybe seriously. Someone in our family. A friend. A coworker. Perhaps someone in the Church. Someone has treated us unfairly, betrayed our trust, spoken badly about us, disappointed us, or wounded us in a way we have never quite forgotten.

Both facts are real. The problem is that we often look at them one at a time. Jesus asks us to open both eyes.

Peter asks Him, "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?" Jesus answers, "Not seven times but seventy-seven times." **Jesus is not giving Peter a larger number to keep track of. He is telling him to stop counting.**

Then He tells the story of a servant who owes his king an enormous debt—one he could never possibly repay. The king forgives everything. But the servant walks outside, finds someone who owes him a much smaller debt, grabs him by the throat and demands payment. Jesus' point is uncomfortable but unmistakable: **How can I receive mercy from God while refusing mercy to someone else?**

We pray it every Sunday: "Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us."

Those are dangerous words if we really mean them. Forgiveness does not mean pretending that evil never happened. It does not mean that trust must immediately be restored or that healthy boundaries are unnecessary. Forgiveness means refusing to allow another person's sin to turn my heart into a prison of resentment.

There is only one heart inside us. We cannot keep it open to God while deliberately keeping it closed to everyone else.

There is a wonderful image of this in the Holy Land: the Sea of Galilee and the Dead Sea. The Jordan River flows into both. But the Sea of Galilee is alive with fish because the water flows into it **and then flows out**. The Dead Sea has no outlet. It receives, but does not give—and nothing can live there. That is a pretty good image of mercy. God's mercy is meant to flow into us and then through us.

Today, as we hold our **Ministry Fair**, we are thinking about the many ways we can serve Christ and His Church. Next Sunday, we will commission those who serve in our parish ministries. But before any particular ministry comes something more fundamental. Every Christian is called to become a minister of God's mercy. So let His mercy flow.

Let your heart be a Sea of Galilee, not a Dead Sea.

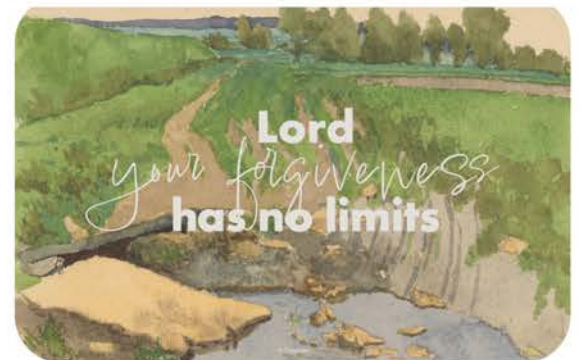

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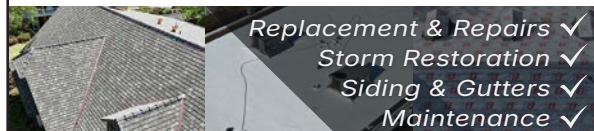
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
