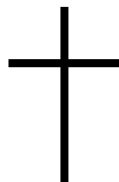


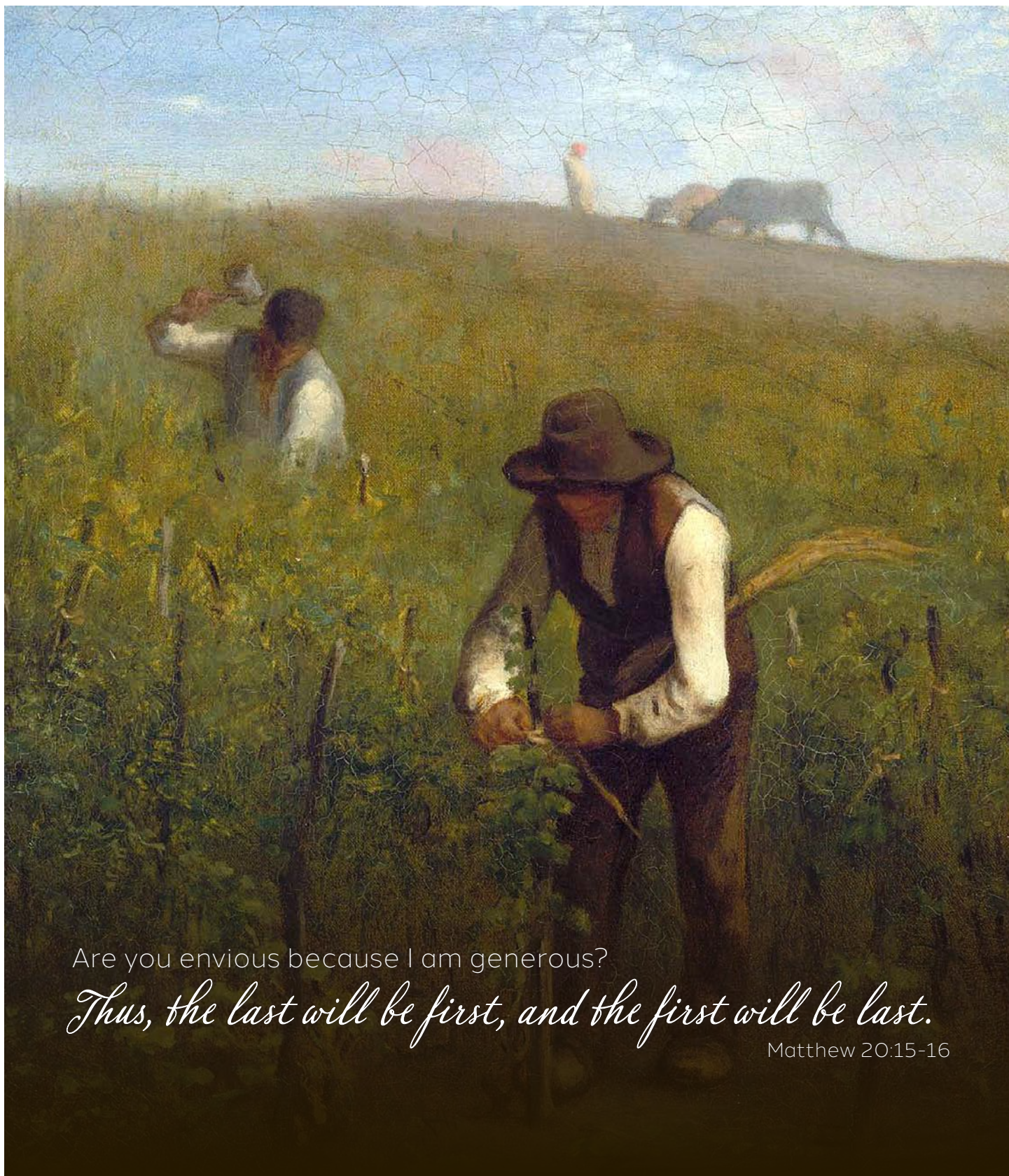

Called into His Vineyard

Serving Without Comparing

Dear Friends:

There is something about this Sunday's Gospel that can bother our sense of fairness.

A landowner goes out early in the morning and hires workers for his vineyard. He returns at nine, at noon, at three, and finally at five o'clock—almost at the end of the working day. Then comes payday.

Those who worked only an hour receive a full day's wage. Naturally, those who worked all day assume they will receive more. They don't. And they complain.

If we are honest, most of us understand their complaint. *That doesn't seem fair.* But notice something important: the landowner has not cheated anyone. Those who worked all day received exactly what they had agreed upon.

The problem is not that the landowner is unjust. The problem is that he is **more generous than they expected**. And suddenly someone else's good fortune becomes a reason for resentment.

Jesus is teaching us something fundamental about God: **God's generosity cannot be measured by what we think someone deserves.**

None of the workers created the vineyard. None created the work. None could demand that the landowner come looking for them in the first place. They were invited. So are we.

Everything begins with grace. Our life is grace. Our faith is grace. Our Baptism is grace. Our place in the Church is grace. Even the ability to serve God is itself a grace.

That is especially appropriate for us next week as we commission those who will serve in the many ministries of our parish.

Some of you have served for decades. You have proclaimed the Scriptures, assisted at the altar, distributed Holy Communion, welcomed people at the doors, sung in the choir, taught the faith, cared for the sanctuary, visited the sick, and quietly performed countless acts of service that most people will never see. **Thank you.**

Others are just beginning. Perhaps you plan to visit our Ministry Fair this weekend and will say yes to something new. **Welcome—and thank you, too.**

Some have labored in the vineyard since early morning. Others have arrived later in the day. But there is only one vineyard, one Lord, and one reason for being there: **He called us.**

Christian service is never about keeping score—who has done more, who has served longer, who receives recognition and who does not. It is about gratitude that the Lord has given us a place in His vineyard at all.

So today I pray especially for all our ministers, veteran and new. May we serve without comparing, give without counting, and rejoice whenever another person answers the Lord's call, because in the end, the greatest reward for working in the vineyard is not what the Master gives us at the end of the day.

It is that He came looking for us and invited us in.

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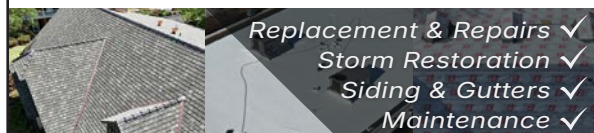


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
