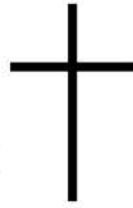

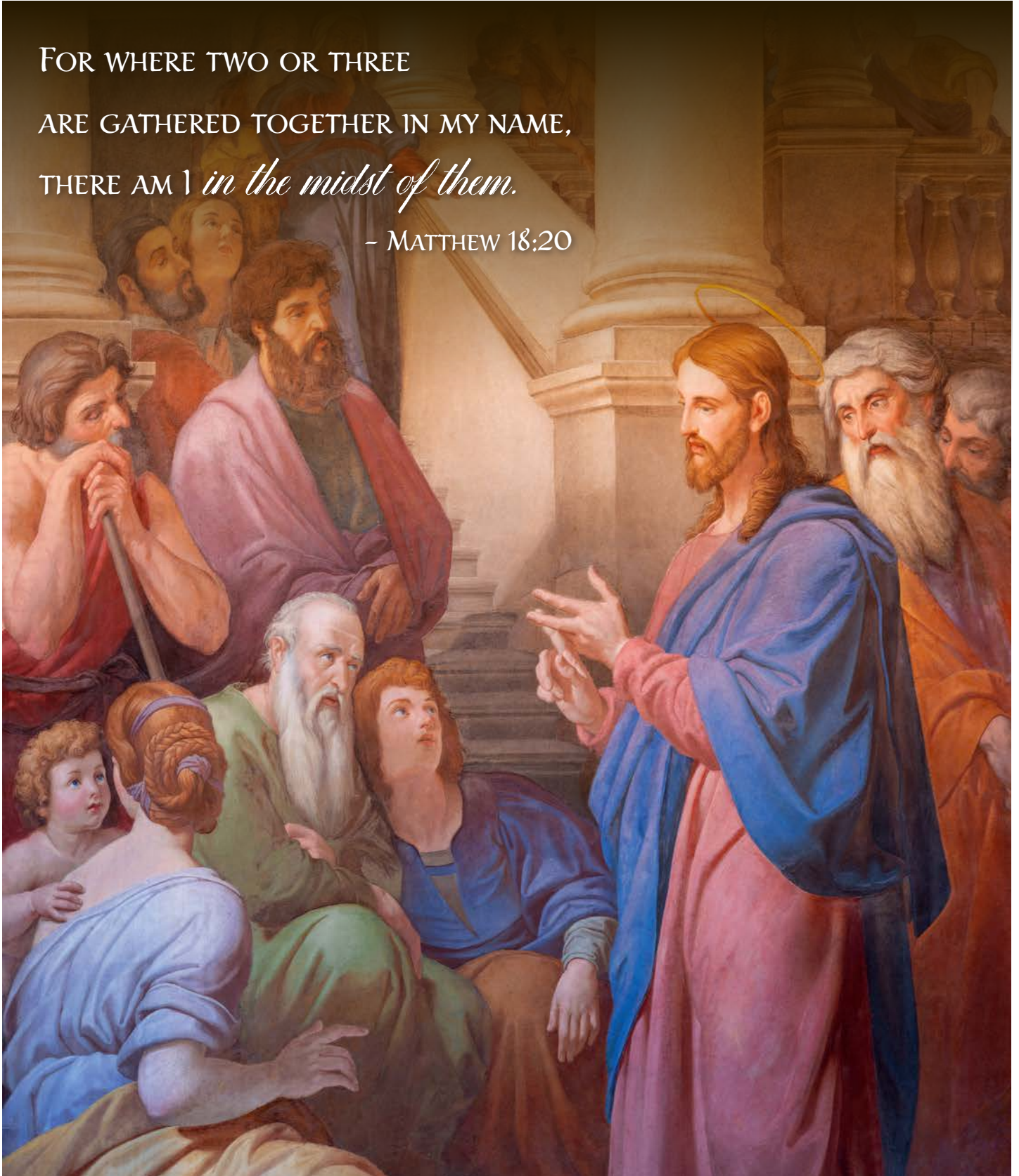

We Need Each Other

Everyone Has a Part

Dear Friends:

One of the great temptations of our time is to think of faith as something entirely private. "My faith is between me and God." There is certainly something true in that. Each of us must have a personal relationship with the Lord. No one else can believe for me, pray for me, repent for me, or ultimately answer for the way I have lived my life.

But Christianity is never merely "Jesus and me." Jesus did not simply gather individual followers. He formed a community. He founded a Church. We see that very clearly in this Sunday's Gospel.

Jesus speaks about what happens when one member of the community sins against another. First, go and speak with him privately. If that does not work, take one or two others. If that fails, "tell the Church."

Then Jesus says something extraordinary: "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." **Our faith is personal, but it is never meant to be private.** From the beginning, Christians have gathered together. They prayed together. They listened to the Word of God together. They celebrated the Eucharist together. They cared for the poor together. And each member brought his or her gifts for the good of the whole Church.

St. Paul would later compare the Church to a body. An eye cannot say to the hand, "I do not need you." Nor can the head say to the feet, "I do not need you." Every member has a place. Every member has something to contribute.

That is worth thinking about as we prepare for our **Ministry Fair** next Sunday.

Our parish needs people willing to serve. Some are called to proclaim the Word of God as Readers. Some assist in the distribution of Holy Communion. Some serve at the altar. Others welcome people as ushers, sing in the choir, care for the church and sanctuary, teach our CCD children, visit the sick, assist the poor, or serve in dozens of less visible ways. (A HUGE THANK YOU to all who currently serve!)

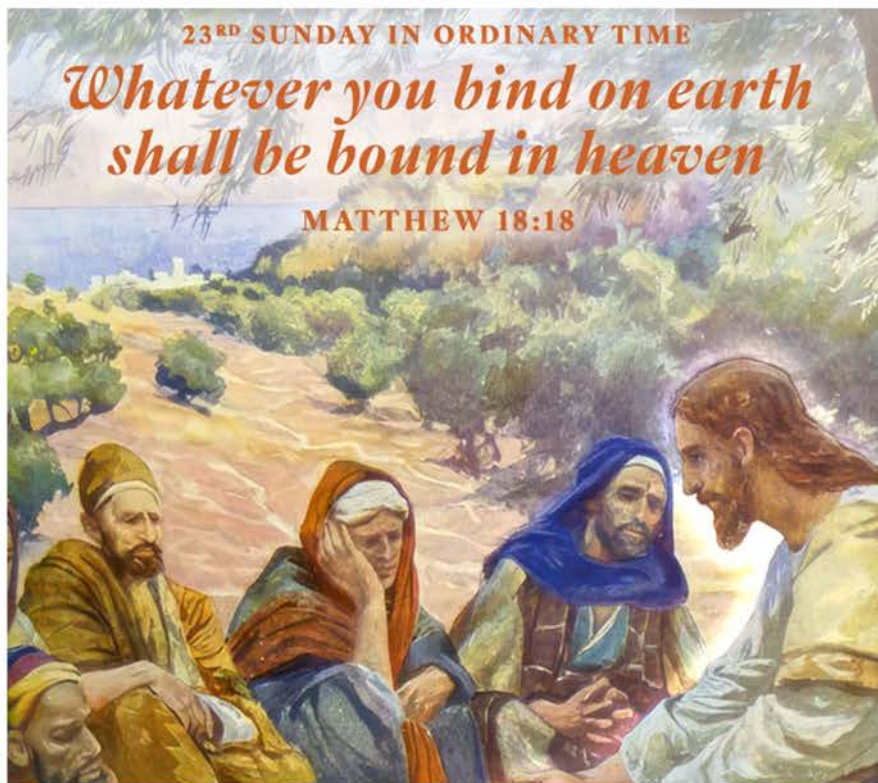
Not everyone can do everything. But everyone can do something. The question is not simply, "What does my parish provide for me?" A mature disciple eventually begins asking another question: "What can I give?"

At every Mass, we bring bread and wine to the altar. But those gifts symbolize something greater. We are meant to bring ourselves—our time, our talents, our abilities, our willingness to serve—and place them at the Lord's disposal.

Next Sunday, take a few minutes to visit our Ministry Fair. Ask questions. Pray about where the Lord might be asking you to serve, **because a parish is strongest not when a few people do everything, but when many people each do something.**

Jesus has given every one of us a place in His Church. Perhaps it is time to discover yours.

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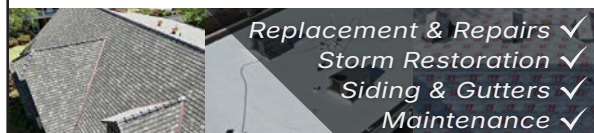


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
