Mystery Wine Fundraiser



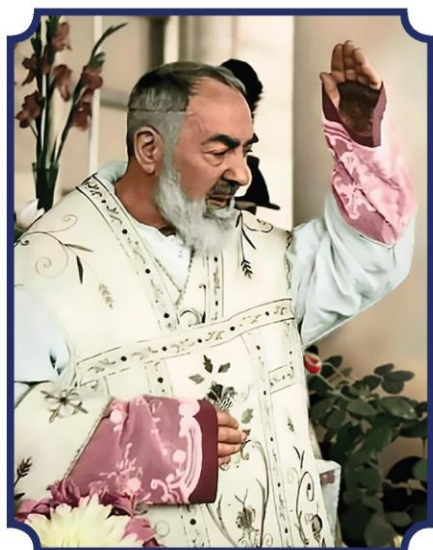
