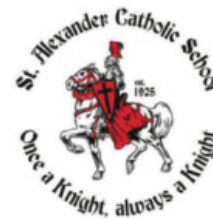


As part of the 100th anniversary celebration, the alumni picnic will take place in the school lot:

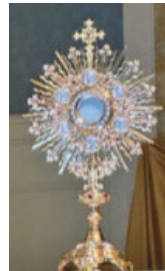

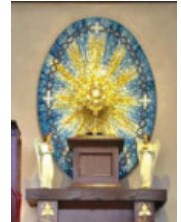

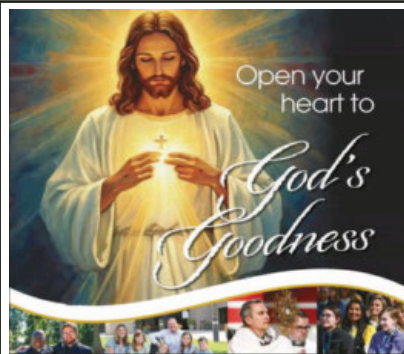
