

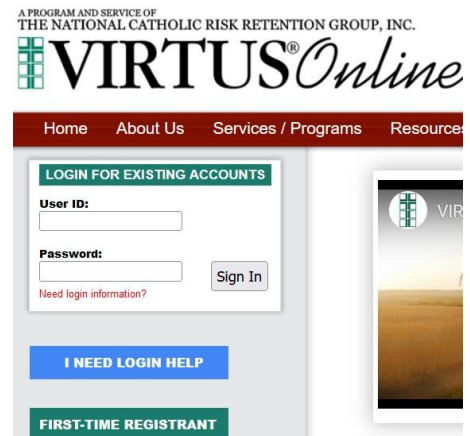
Information specific to Teen Volunteers

Safe Environments at St. Anastasia

All Teen Volunteers (14—17 years old) must complete Safe Environments training.

If you have not already done so, you must create an account and complete the 35 minute training video asap...

- Go to **www.virtus.org**
- Click on First-Time Registrant box
- Click on Begin the Registration Process
- Select “Detroit, MI Archdiocese”
- Have you previously registered with VIRTUS Online?
- Create User ID (be sure to write down and save)
- Create Password (be sure to write down and save)
- Click on Continue
- Add in your information
- Select where you volunteer, work, etc.: - St Anastasia Parish (Troy)
- Select your primary role (Volunteer—either more or less than 3x/year)
- Are you associated with any other location – Yes or No
- Do you interact with minors? - Yes
- Do you interact with vulnerable adults? - No
- Do you manage or oversee others on behalf of this organization? - No
- Here you may be presented with a Code of Conduct - if not—just keep going... or if you are, then read, check the box at the end, fill in your full name and date
- Have you already attended Protecting God’s Children? – No
- You will be assigned the appropriate training video—click on the link to begin and be sure to let us know that you completed the training.
