_____ The collection of ancient biblical texts that are inspired by God and reveal his nature and presence to his people.

_____ Our deliverance, through Jesus Christ, from the powers of sin and death.

_____ The latter part of the Bible, which details the life, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, along with the early history of his Church.
