_____ The holy name of God, first spoken to Moses. It is the English translation of the four-letter Hebrew word YHWH (commonly pronounced "Yahweh").

_____ The Jewish feast that commemorates the night when God "passed over" the Israelite homes in Egypt, protecting their children from death and freeing them from slavery.

_____ The wooden, gold-covered chest that held the two stone tablets of the Ten Commandments and other sacred objects of the Israelites.

_____ The portable tent that the Israelites used for worship in the desert. It housed the Ark of the Covenant.

_____ The twelve leaders of Israel who were chosen by God to help defend the Israelites from their enemies.

_____ The heavenly food that God gave the Israelites while they wandered in the desert.

_____ A series of devastating catastrophes that fell upon the Egyptians after Pharaoh refused to let the Israelites go and worship God.
