_____ On Wednesdays from 1979 to 1984, St. John Paul II gave talks about how the human body reveals that human persons are created male and female in the image of God, with freedom for loving relationships and called to make a gift of ourselves on our way to happiness in heaven. These teachings are known as this.

_____ God created this in his image and likeness for our own sake—just so he could love us and we could return that love. Everyone is made unique and unrepeatable, male or female, with a body and soul.

_____ This is someone who has lived a holy life, practiced virtue to a heroic degree, and chosen to love God above all things. They come from every place, ethnicity, circumstance, and background. They may be priests or nuns, married, single, or even children. The Catholic Church canonizes (gives the title “Saint” to) these holy people to offer us examples of how we, too, should live. We are all called to live holy lives.

_____ This refers to Jesus, who is fully God, becoming fully man. God the Son became man to reveal the truth of our humanity and save us from the destruction caused by sin.
