_____ After the loss of grace in Original Sin, we have a tendency toward sin and selfishness. This tendency is caused by our damaged desires, which are called concupiscence.

_____ This is the choice not to follow God's laws. When we sin, we do something God says we should not do or we fail to do something God says we should do. This is a failure to love God and others.

_____ He was an angel who rejected God's will. He became the enemy of love and tempted Adam and Eve to sin. He is called "the father of lies" because he tempts us to sin with false promises of happiness.

_____ God created us with the ability to choose so that we are able to love. This ability to choose is necessary because love must be freely chosen and given. God wanted us to love him and each other, so he gave us free will.

_____ This refers to Adam and Eve's sin and its damaging effect on all of humanity. God designed human nature with the grace of holiness and the ability to choose what is good. Original Sin is the loss of this grace. Original Sin damages our ability to know what is right, choose what is good, and love; it causes us to suffer and even die; and it makes us tend to commit sin, even when we try not to.

_____ In the Garden of Eden, God created the first human persons fully able to live his plan of happiness for them. The way God originally created Adam and Eve is the way human beings were designed to live.
