_____ A sacramental, holy bond, binding until death, between a baptized man and woman and God. It calls for a free, total, faithful, and fruitful relationship that is open to bringing new life into the world. Marriage is a sign of Christ and the Church.

_____ In consecrated life, orders are different religious communities with distinct ways of life that fulfill different needs in the Church.

_____ A calling from God to a particular path in life that will best fulfill your strengths, heal your weaknesses, and help you become a saint. Each person has a universal call to holiness that is received at Baptism.

_____ The sacrament received when a man is ordained as a priest, deacon, or bishop.

_____ A vocation in which a man or a woman makes vows to God instead of to a spouse. Consecrated people do not marry or own many possessions so that they will have more time, energy, and focus to do special work for God. They often live in a community of others with the same call. Consecrated religious men are called "brothers" or "monks" while consecrated religious women are called "nuns" or "sisters."
