Orders are now being taken for engraved pavers at Veterans Memorial Way at St. Ann's Cemetery.

- Each paver is for honoring a veteran, living or deceased. If you are purchasing a brick in honor of a deceased veteran, it is not required that they are buried at St. Ann's Cemetery.
- Pavers are 4"x 8".
- Each brick may be engraved with up to three (3) lines and fourteen (14) characters max per line. Each letter is approximately 3/4". *(Please note if a line contains many large characters the engraver may notify us that it won't fit. In this case we will notify you and let you choose how to edit.)*
- There are two types of bricks that may be purchased (*see next page for picture*):
 1. Gray pavers (\$150 each): These pavers are part of the cross design in the walkway.
Note: there are a limited number of gray pavers available.
 2. Red pavers (\$100 each): These pavers are not part of the cross design.

Please use the grids on the reverse side to write the words you would like engraved.

The suggested format is:

Line 1: Veteran's Name

Line 2: Rank and branch of service

Line 3: Name of war or conflict and/or years served

Note: Each block in the grid below is one character. Spaces count as one character. Hyphens count as one character. Periods and apostrophes can be placed in the same block with the letter/number it's next to.
