

What Is Scrip?

Scrip is a term that means “substitute money”. When you purchase Scrip gift cards, you’re purchasing gift cards that are used just like cash. You can use Scrip gift cards to pay for everyday items like food, clothing, gas, dining out, etc., and with every purchase, you’re earning income for our parish.

How does Scrip generate revenue for St. Gabriel Parish?

RaiseRight acts on behalf of churches, schools and other non-profit organizations to purchase large volumes of gift cards from grocery stores, department stores, and other retailers. Participating retailers sell the gift cards at a discount of 2%-20%. St. Gabriel Parish buys the gift cards from RaiseRight at the discounted price and then sells them to parishioners at the full-face value. The difference between the two is income for our parish.

Scrip is "shopping cart fundraising"

Scrip is a popular fundraiser because families don't have to sell anything. St. Gabriel parishioners generate revenue by making purchases they would regularly make anyway - groceries, clothing, toys, gifts, gas, and dining out can all be paid for with gift cards purchased through our parish Scrip program.
