



Confirmation Preparation Expectations

8th Grade (& Up)



All students must attend mass each week.

- Any mass at any parish will work. (Saturday or Sunday Mass)

All students must attend class.

- Classes will be on the first Sunday of each Month (September-May) from 9:30-10:30 am.
- Parents must attend any family formation classes (TBA).

*All students must complete a total of 20
volunteer service hours.*

- Service hours can be obtained in 2 categories:

Service towards others

This can be done through the parish, community, and/or family. This includes Service like helping with a parish event, mowing your elderly neighbor's lawn, or helping your grandparent clean their home.

Strengthening your spiritual life

This can be done through participation in the ample church traditions and sacraments that the Catholic church offers. This includes participation in Adoration, Stations of the Cross (lent), the Sacrament of Reconciliation, bible study, etc.

- The 20 total hours should be a mix of strengthening your spiritual life and serving others.
- Volunteer forms must be filled out for all the services provided and/or participation in the parish. Volunteer forms can be found on our parish website under "Confirmation Preparation." Copies are also available in our parish office.

*Students must complete a saint
project on their chosen saint.*

*Students must write a letter to Father
requesting the Sacrament of
Confirmation.*

- Guidelines for these projects are posted on our parish website and will be shared by catechists in class when appropriate.

Students must attend this year's Religious Retreat (TBA)
