



## Letter to Father Guidelines for 8th Grade (& Up)

*You will be writing a letter to Father William asking to be Confirmed. The formatting should be as follows:*

- It should be a typed, one-page long letter.
- The beginning of your letter should say: “Dear Father William...”
- The end of your letter should be signed with your name.
- The finished letter should be put in an envelope addressed to: **Rev. William Agyemang.**
- You have the option of mailing it to the parish by the due date or handing it in person during class on the due date.

*You should include the following in your letter:*

1. Who are you? Introduce yourself and tell something about yourself. Hobbies, interests, siblings, sports, etc.
2. Ask Father to be Confirmed in the Catholic Church. “I am asking for Confirmation in the Catholic Church.”
3. Explain why **YOU** wish to be Confirmed.
4. Explain what **YOUR** plan in the future is as a Catholic. How can you implement what you've learned through your service work and class time out in the real world? What ways will you get involved in your parish? How can you live in a way that glorifies God?
5. Who did you choose as a patron saint? Why?
