



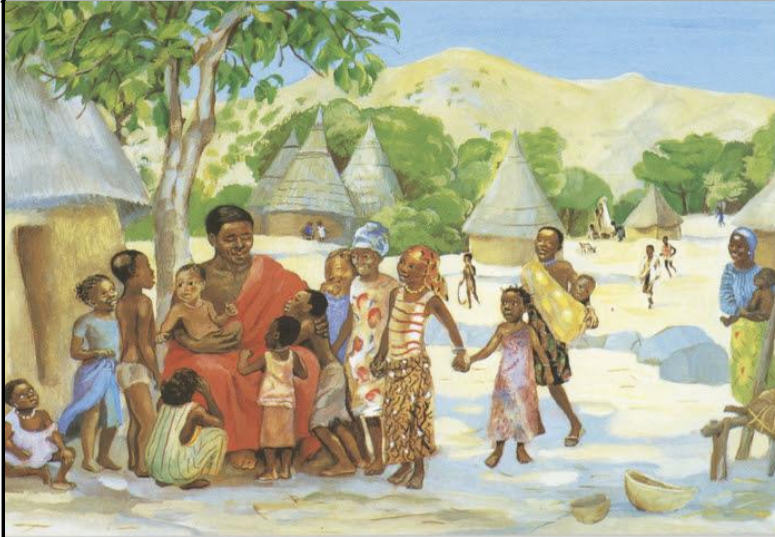

To welcome the missionary is to welcome God (Mt 10)

Brothers and Sisters

On this 13th Sunday, Jesus speaks to his apostles whom he sends on a mission. He announces to them that they will be received or rejected, and that every welcome concerning them is in reality a welcome or a rejection of God himself. This identification is striking: “Who welcomes you welcomes me, and who welcomes me welcomes the One who sent me.”

Christ then goes down to the most basic gesture: a glass of fresh water offered “to one of these little ones.” Nothing is too tiny in the eyes of God. Any gesture of authentic welcome is invested with eternal value.

There is also a requirement: to love God more than father or mother, son or daughter. Not out of family indifference, but because only this first love can order and sanctify all others. He who takes his cross and follows Christ paradoxically discovers the fullness of his life.

Question of reflection: How do I welcome the servants of God: priests, catechists, missionaries? Do I see God in the face of the poor man who is approaching me?

Parish Information

Sacrament of Baptism (Infant): Our Baptisms are celebrated on the **fourth Sunday** of every month. Parents and godparents **are required** to attend **two (2)** preparation classes. Registration forms are available in the church office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 anytime for an anointing of the sick and dying. The priests visit our sick and shut-ins **every Friday with Holy Communion**.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm at the Shrine.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick **every Friday**. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

The Sacrament of Matrimony: Please contact the priest **six (6) months** prior to the date of the intended wedding. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans. **Marriage preparation is mandatory.**

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Church Cleaning: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Catechesis

Why should parents require their children to read at least one hour a day during vacation?

Vacation is an opportunity to learn in different ways. Yes, children need to play, exercise, rest, and engage in fun activities. But there's one habit parents should never let slip during vacation: reading.

A child who reads develops their intelligence, imagination, vocabulary, critical thinking, and ability to concentrate. Conversely, a child who grows up spending all their time in front of screens may struggle to think deeply, learn, and persevere—even to read a few pages.

Yet the world of tomorrow will demand men and women capable of understanding, analyzing, learning continuously, and adapting. Without a solid reading culture, many risk being left behind.

During these vacation days, give your children age-appropriate books. Replace some of their screen time with an hour of reading each day. Then ask them to tell you what they understood. This simple exercise can change their future. Raising a reader means preparing a child for life. Because today, learning to read is no longer a luxury—it's a matter of the future.
