



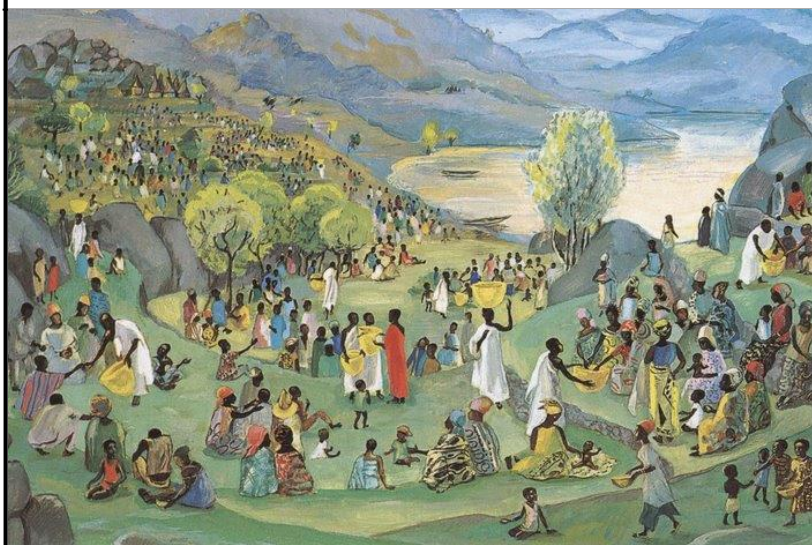

WEEKLY REFLECTION

Brothers and sisters

This Sunday's Gospel is, at its heart, a story about compassion before it is a story about abundance. Jesus has just learned of John the Baptist's death; he withdraws to a deserted place to pray, and it is the crowd — hungry and weary — who comes looking for him. Rather than send them away, he is "moved with pity for them."

Faced with so little — five loaves, two fish — the disciples see impossibility. Jesus sees an offering that is enough once placed in God's hands. He does not conjure food from nothing: he takes what is already there, blesses it, breaks it, and gives it. It is the same gesture we celebrate at every Eucharist.

Brothers and sisters, we too are often tempted to measure our resources — of time, talent, or faith — and conclude they are not enough for the needs around us. This Gospel invites us into a different logic: the logic of trusting gift. Whatever we place in Christ's hands, however small, he blesses and makes abundant for the good of all.

Bishop's Appeal: Thus far, we have contributed **\$26,385.00** towards our goal of **\$35,000**. We thank all who have already returned their envelopes, and we continue to encourage those who have not yet contributed to drop their envelope in the collection basket or directly at the church office.

You can view the provisional list of contributions for the Bishop's Appeal, provided by the chancery, on the bulletin board.

Cassi Hill Pilgrimage: Holy Family Parish invites its Parishioners, all Parishes, and the entire community to participate in the 79th Annual Pilgrimage of Our Lady of Cassi Hill. The pilgrimage will take place on **Sunday, August 16, 2026**, starting at 2:00 PM from the Four Winds Plaza to the Shrine.

Seminarians: We say goodbye to our Seminarians **Bro. Paul Duru** and **Bro. Karim Henry**. We thank them for their work well done and for their summer experience at Holy Family. We also welcome our two seminarians **Bro. Giuseppe** and **Bro. Juliot** as they also come for their summer experience at Holy Family.

Devotional Space by the Left Side of the Church: We encourage parishioners to have a moment of silence with the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Sacred Immaculate Heart of Mary. We can also pray for the intercession of St. Joseph, Our Lady of Perpetual Help, and Our Lady of Czestochowa.

Air Conditioning Project: We've made great progress on the air conditioning project for our church, but we still have **many bills to pay (urgent matter)**. We're counting on our parishioners and visitors to help us cover these costs so that we can finally enjoy this amenity in time for our parish's jubilee.

To date, we have advanced **\$377,155.11**. The remaining **balance** for completion of the project is **\$167,915.59**. Fr. Modeste is encouraging any initiative from parishioners and visitors that can help us raise additional funds.

The Church's Stained-Glass Windows: We still have twelve stained-glass windows to install. We encourage parishioners and visitors to donate a stained-glass window for our church for \$5000, and your family's name will be commemorated on it.

Weekly Diocesan Radio Program: Parishioners are invited to tune in to **"VI Catholic Voice"** on WSTA 1340 AM every **Thursday at 7:00 pm** and re-broadcast on **Sundays at 12:00 noon**, or on **Spotify** or **Apple Podcasts**.

Weekday Masses: Parishioners are encouraged to attend the **7:00 am daily weekday Masses**; or the **Wednesday noon Mass**.

Parish Information

Sacrament of Baptism (Infant): Our Baptisms are celebrated on the **fourth Sunday** of every month. Parents and godparents **are required** to attend **two (2)** preparation classes. Registration forms are available in the church office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Classes: RCIA is the journey of faith by which interested persons become members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program instructs adults to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church through Baptism and/or Confirmation and Holy Communion. To register, please call the church office at (340) 775-1650.

CCD Religious Education/Faith Formation: CCD classes take place every Saturday from 9:00 AM - 12 noon.

Sacrament of Penance: Confession is the sacrament that allows us to admit our faults and develop humility, but the most profound part is we get to experience Christ's gift of mercy. Confessions will be on Wednesdays after the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and on weekends 20 minutes before each Mass.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please call the church office at (340) 775-1650 anytime for an anointing of the sick and dying. The priests visit our sick and shut-ins **every Friday with Holy Communion**.

Healing Mass: A healing Mass is held the last Friday of every month at 6:00 pm at the Shrine.

Visiting the Sick: The parish priests visit the sick **every Friday**. Please call the office if you have a sick or shut-it that you would like added to the list for home visits.

Funerals: All funeral services begin at 10:00 a.m. No funerals are held on weekends. Arrangements must be made with the Church before funeral arrangements with the funeral home. Viewing in church is available, however, we encourage viewing at funeral home.

The Sacrament of Matrimony: Please contact the priest **six (6) months** prior to the date of the intended wedding. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans. **Marriage preparation is mandatory.**

Parish Registration: Parishioners who are 18 years and older are encouraged to complete a parish registration form. We would like to maintain an up-to-date listing of all Holy Family parishioners. Registration helps in providing letters of request for proof of church membership. Also, if you have relocated or your mailing address or contact number has changed, please update it at the church office.

Church Cleaning: The church is cleaned every Friday of the Month at 6:30 p.m. Volunteers are needed and welcomed.

Masses at the Shrine are held on **Fridays at 7:00 am**. Healing Masses are held on the last Friday of the month. The next Healing Mass will take place on **August 28th at 6:00 pm**.

Catechesis

August, Another Month of Mary.

Introduction (part 1)

We know May well as the month par excellence dedicated to the Virgin Mary, and October as the month of the Holy Rosary. But the Church's tradition also gives August a special place in Marian devotion. This is no accident: the liturgical heart of August is the great solemnity of the Assumption on August 15, which radiates over the whole month and gives it a distinctly Marian character.

Three major Marian feasts mark the month of August and explain the popular tradition — especially alive in many African and European churches — of regarding August as a “second month of Mary”:

1. August 5 — Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major in Rome, the oldest church in the West dedicated to the Mother of God.
2. August 15 — Solemnity of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary: taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven, Mary becomes the sign of hope and the final destiny of every believer.
3. August 22 — Memorial of the Queenship of Mary, which extends and crowns the mystery of the Assumption: raised beside her Son, Mary reigns with him as Mother and Queen.

This trio of feasts makes August a strong season for contemplating Mary not only as a model of listening and availability (as in May), but as the glorified woman, our advocate and our hope.
