Living the stewardship way of life is not easy. Dying to self and living for Christ and others requires sacrifice. It is the work of a lifetime. Yet it is also the only work that truly matters and the only life that ultimately satisfies.

In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus tells His disciples, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross and follow me." At first, those words may sound difficult to accept. Why would anyone willingly embrace such a path?

Jesus immediately gives us the answer: "Whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."

Everything comes down to love. Jesus loved us completely, giving Himself for us on the Cross. He continues to give Himself to us through His Word and, most especially, in the Eucharist.

Each day we are faced with a choice: to live for ourselves or to live for God and for others. The second path is more demanding, but it leads to lasting joy and the promise of eternal life. May we choose each day to lose our lives for Christ's sake, offering them back to Him in grateful response to His immeasurable love.

Starting the first week in September (5-6), all children preparing for 1st communion and confirmation need to get their sheet signed on the way OUT, after Mass.

Sponsor Orphans

Our orphanage in our sister parish in Uganda now has 87 orphans. There are over 100 more orphans scattered throughout the various villages where we have a church and a Catholic school. These orphans are taken in by relatives who need help to feed them and pay school tuition.

The average cost for a full year to feed an orphan and pay their total tuition for the year is only \$250. We see to it that each orphan is fed, has a bed to sleep in and has full security either with another family or in the orphanage. Each orphan has the opportunity to go to Catholic school through grade school, high school and college or university if they have the grades. They have a choice of four trade schools if they do not have the academic grades to qualify for college or university. We already have orphans who graduated from college and now have good jobs teaching or nursing, etc.

Would you like to sponsor an orphan? If so, make your check out to Blessed Trinity for \$250 and write "for an orphan" on the memo line. Not a cent will be wasted. It has great spiritual value for your donation. Thanks so much.

So far we have received payment for 44 orphans!

Each year when we visit Uganda we are privileged to be at the last two graduations. We have four trade schools in our sister parish—one carpentry school, two tailor schools and one home economics school. Each girl who graduates from one of our tailor schools gets from us, a Singler sewing machine and \$100. They get so excited and are so very thankful. With the money they can start up and buy some material and accept small jobs to begin with. They work from home. It is now up to them to grow their own business.

We had 44 girls graduate this June. Our gift to each graduate costs us \$250—\$150 for the sewing machine and \$100 to get started.

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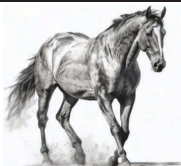

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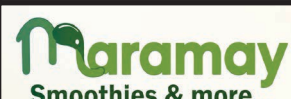
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
