Today's readings invite us to examine the state of our hearts — our thoughts, attitudes, and emotions. In our First Reading from Sirach, we hear about the destructive power of anger: "Could anyone nourish anger against another and expect healing from the Lord?"

All of us have been hurt by others at some point, some more deeply than others. While our emotions are gifts from God, we are called to steward them well rather than allowing them to control us. How do we do that? Sirach gives us the answer: "Remember your last days, set enmity aside... Remember the Most High's covenant and overlook faults." Instead of dwelling on past hurts, we choose gratitude. We remember God's countless blessings, His unfailing mercy, and His faithful love, placing our trust in Him.

In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us of who we are before God through the parable of the unforgiving servant. A king forgives a debt so enormous it could never be repaid, yet the servant refuses to extend that same mercy to someone else.

The story should sound familiar. God has given us life, forgiven our sins through His Son, and opened the way to eternal life. We could never repay such a gift. The only fitting response is to offer Him our whole lives and to extend the same mercy and forgiveness He has shown to us.

That is the freedom and joy found in the stewardship way of life.

During the weekend of **September 19-20**, baby bottles will be distributed after each Mass.

All donations will benefit Alpha Center for Women, an Ocala pregnancy resource center that provides life-affirming alternatives to abortion, material support during and after pregnancy, post-abortion recovery services, and mentoring programs for parents in need. Since 2006, the generous parishioners of Blessed Trinity have contributed **nearly \$143,000** to support this important ministry, while also helping sustain our sponsorship of two students in Uganda and the Uganda Orphanage. Last year, Alpha Center for Women added **155 new families** by providing pregnancy tests and meeting material needs through its Bridges Program. The center recorded **nearly 2,100 client visits** and distributed **more than 33,500 essential items**, including diapers, wipes, clothing, food, and furniture. Assistance was also provided through utility support, gas cards, and grocery gift cards.

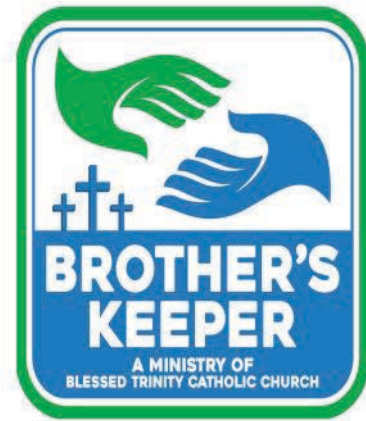

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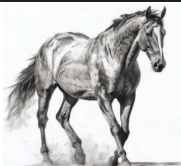
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
