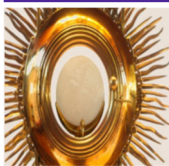

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FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

Happy All Saints Day!

On this solemnity, I invite you to open up the Catechism of the Catholic Church to explore a line that we say in the Creed every Sunday. Paragraph 946 says: After confessing "the holy catholic Church," the Apostles' Creed adds "the communion of saints." In a certain sense this article is a further explanation of the preceding: "What is the Church if not the assembly of all the saints?" The communion of saints is the Church.

Last weekend, I started preaching on the communion of saints, but wanted to leave the bulk of that preaching for today. This is something that is central to our Catholic faith because we profess it every Sunday in the Creed and every time we start to pray the rosary. In paragraph 954, the Catechism goes deeper into explaining this by teaching us about the "three states of the Church:

"When the Lord comes in glory, and all his angels with him, death will be no more and all things will be subject to him. But at the present time some of his disciples are pilgrims on earth. Others have died and are being purified, while still others are in glory, contemplating 'in full light, God himself triune and one, exactly as he is.'"

Many of you may recall your old Baltimore Catechism days of learning about the Church Militant (here on earth), the Church Penitent (the blessed souls in purgatory), and the Church Triumphant (saints in heaven). When we celebrate the Eucharist, we are united in a profound way with those who have gone before us. The reason I mentioned the communion of saints last week was because I was preaching our annual Pregnancy and Infant Loss Mass. I was telling the parents who have lost little ones that even in our liturgy, the Church affirms that these innocent souls are in heaven and that through the communion of saints we are united to them through the Holy Eucharist.

On this day, we celebrate the saints in heaven that are models for us of how to love Christ and who are now in heaven, but tomorrow on All Soul's Day and throughout the month of November, we pray for the Church Penitent: the souls in purgatory who are being purified. The Catechism affirms in paragraph 958 that we are also in communion with our faithful departed:

Communion with the dead. "In full consciousness of this communion of the whole Mystical Body of Jesus Christ, the Church in its pilgrim members, from the very earliest days of the Christian religion, has honored with great respect the memory of the dead; and 'because it is a holy and a wholesome thought to pray for the dead that they may be loosed from their sins' she offers her suffrages for them." Our prayer for them is capable not only of helping them, but also of making their intercession for us effective.

Tomorrow on All Soul's Day, we will have the opportunity to come together to pray for the souls of our departed loved ones. At 7:00 p.m., we will have a solemn Mass for All Souls, and I invite you to bring a picture of your departed family members so that we may place them on the altar rail. During the offertory, I will incense those pictures as we pray that their souls be received by God so that they may not only receive the merits of heaven, but may also intercede for us until we all meet in the heavenly kingdom.

Finally, after the All Soul's Day Mass has concluded, we will expose the Blessed Sacrament in our church for 24 hours to pray for our nation during this upcoming Election Day. When we kneel before Christ in the Blessed Sacrament, all the angels and saints in heaven join us. I remember one of my spiritual directors in seminary telling me to picture when we pray all our favorite saints sitting with us adoring the Lord and interceding for us. So, I invite you to come and spend an hour with our Lord during this most important time in our nation's history. Father Omar will give Benediction at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday night to conclude the 24-hour devotion. Also, and this should go without saying at this point, please vote! It is our moral obligation as Catholics to participate in the political process as we seek to build up the Kingdom of God here on earth. We pray for our nation through the intercession of Mary, the Immaculate Conception who is the patroness of the United States, and we pray for peace in our hearts and throughout this great land this week. We hope to see you this week at the altar of the Lord as we unite in prayer with all the saints.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

¡Feliz Día de Todos los Santos!

En esta solemnidad, los invito a que abran el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica para explorar una frase que decimos en el Credo todos los domingos. El párrafo 946 dice: Después de haber confesado "la santa Iglesia católica", el Credo de los Apóstoles añade "la comunión de los santos". En cierto sentido, este artículo es una explicación más de lo anterior: "¿Qué es la Iglesia si no la asamblea de todos los santos?" La comunión de los santos es la Iglesia.

El fin de semana pasado, comencé a predicar sobre la comunión de los santos, pero quería dejar la mayor parte de esa predicación para hoy. Esto es algo que es fundamental para nuestra fe católica porque lo profesamos todos los domingos en el Credo y cada vez que comenzamos a rezar el rosario. En el párrafo 954, el Catecismo profundiza en explicar esto enseñándonos acerca de los "tres estados de la Iglesia."

"Cuando el Señor venga en la gloria, y todos sus ángeles con él, la muerte no será más y todas las cosas estarán sujetas a él. Pero en la actualidad algunos de sus discípulos son peregrinos en la tierra. Otros han muerto y están siendo purificados, mientras que otros están en la gloria, contemplando 'a plena luz, a Dios mismo trino y uno, exactamente como es'".

Muchos de ustedes recordarán sus viejos días de aprendizaje del Catecismo de Baltimore acerca de la Iglesia Militante (aquí en la tierra), la Iglesia Penitente (las almas benditas en el purgatorio) y la Iglesia Triunfante (los santos en el cielo). Cuando celebramos la Eucaristía, estamos unidos de manera profunda con los que nos han precedido. La razón por la que mencioné la comunión de los santos la semana pasada fue porque estaba predicando en nuestra misa anual de embarazo y pérdida infantil. Les decía a los padres que han perdido a sus pequeños que incluso en nuestra liturgia, la Iglesia afirma que estas almas inocentes están en el cielo y que a través de la comunión de los santos estamos unidos a ellos a través de la Santa Eucaristía.

En este día, celebramos a los santos en los cielos que son modelos para nosotros de cómo amar a Cristo y que ahora están en el cielo, pero mañana en el Día de los Fieles Difuntos y durante todo el mes de noviembre, oramos por la Iglesia Penitente: las almas en el purgatorio que están siendo purificadas. El Catecismo afirma en el párrafo 958 que también estamos en comunión con nuestros fieles difuntos: Comunión con los muertos. "En plena conciencia de esta

comunión de todo el Cuerpo místico de Jesucristo, la Iglesia en sus miembros peregrinos, desde los primeros días de la religión cristiana, ha honrado con gran respeto la memoria de los muertos; y 'porque es un pensamiento santo y sano orar por los muertos para que sean liberados de sus pecados', ella ofrece sus sufragios por ellos." Nuestra oración por ellos es capaz no sólo de ayudarlos, sino también de hacer efectiva su intercesión por nosotros.

Mañana, en el Día de los Fieles Difuntos, tendremos la oportunidad de reunirnos para orar por las almas de nuestros seres queridos difuntos. A las 7:00 p.m., tendremos una misa solemne para todos los fieles difuntos, y los invito a traer una foto de sus familiares difuntos para que podamos colocarlos en el carril del altar. Durante el ofertorio, incienso esas fotos mientras oramos para que sus almas sean recibidas por Dios para que no sólo reciban los méritos del cielo, sino que también intercedan por nosotros hasta que todos nos encontremos en el reino celestial.

Finalmente, después de que la Misa del Día de los Fieles Difuntos haya concluido, expondremos el Santísimo Sacramento en nuestra iglesia durante 24 horas para orar por nuestra nación durante este próximo día de elecciones. Cuando nos arrodillamos ante Cristo en el Santísimo Sacramento, todos los ángeles y santos del cielo se unen a nosotros. Recuerdo que uno de mis directores espirituales del seminario me dijo que me imaginara cuando oramos a todos nuestros santos favoritos sentados con nosotros adorando al Señor e intercediendo por nosotros. Por lo tanto, los invito a venir y pasar una hora con nuestro Señor durante este momento tan importante en la historia de nuestra nación. El Padre Omar dará la Bendición a las 7:00 p.m. del martes por la noche para concluir la devoción de 24 horas. Además, y esto debe ir sin decir en este punto, ¡por favor voten! Es nuestra obligación moral como católicos participar en el proceso político mientras buscamos edificar el Reino de Dios aquí en la tierra. Oremos por nuestra nación a través de la intercesión de María, la Inmaculada Concepción que es la patrona de los Estados Unidos, y oremos por la paz en nuestros corazones y en toda esta gran nación esta semana. Esperamos verlos esta semana en el altar del Señor mientras nos unimos en oración con todos los santos.

SUNDAY MASS READINGS — LECTURAS DE LA MISA DOMINICAL

First Reading

RV 7:2-4, 9-14

I, John, saw another angel come up from the East, holding the seal of the living God. He cried out in a loud voice to the four angels who were given power to damage the land and the sea, "Do not damage the land or the sea or the trees until we put the seal on the foreheads of the servants of our God."

I heard the number of those who had been marked with the seal, one hundred and forty-four thousand marked from every tribe of the children of Israel. After this I had a vision of a great multitude, which no one could count, from every nation, race, people, and tongue. They stood before the throne and before the Lamb, wearing white robes and holding palm branches in their hands. They cried out in a loud voice: "Salvation comes from our God, who is seated on the throne, and from the Lamb."

All the angels stood around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures. They prostrated themselves before the throne, worshiped God, and exclaimed: "Amen. Blessing and glory, wisdom and thanksgiving, honor, power, and might be to our God forever and ever. Amen."

Then one of the elders spoke up and said to me, "Who are these wearing white robes, and where did they come from?" I said to him, "My lord, you are the one who knows." He said to me, "These are the ones who have survived the time of great distress; they have washed their robes and made them white in the Blood of the Lamb."
