FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

As gather this Sunday on All Hallow's Eve, we think about the Solemnity we celebrate tomorrow, All Saints Day, and the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed that we celebrate the day after. We recall that we are all called to be saints, and that as good Christians, we have an obligation to pray for our deceased loved ones and for all who have died.

The Catholic tradition of offering Masses for our loved ones, especially those who have died, can be traced to the beginnings of the Catholic Church. In the Eucharist we are united in a unique way with the faithful departed and the Communion of Saints. Why do we offer Masses for our loved ones? Let's look to the Catechism of the Catholic Church: "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. (1030)." Our prayers help them achieve the glories of heaven and the perfect prayer is the Mass. Pope Leo XIII reminded us well over a century ago that if our loved ones have already achieved their eternal reward, they pray for us during Mass in a "mutual exchange" of prayer. Praying for the dead is also one of the spiritual works of mercy.

Offering Masses is an important part of our tradition as they can also be offered in thanksgiving for the health of a loved one and for special intentions. It is an honor and a duty for me and my brother priests of the parish to offer these intentions during the Sacrifice of the

Mass as part of our priestly ministry. We are blessed in this parish for we offer many intentions weekly during our daily and Sunday Masses that are set aside by our faithful. Our staff in the parish office do an exemplary job in organizing the Mass intentions with the sacred care they deserve.

On Wednesday, November 10, we will start taking Mass Intentions for 2022. If you want to offer a Mass on the anniversary of the death or the birthday of a loved one, we kindly ask you to do it way in advance. The offering of a Mass is a sacred act that deserves our attention and care so we ask that you call our office or do this in person at the office early to avoid any errors. Always remember that the priest, even if he doesn't explicitly say the name of the deceased or of the intention, is still offering the Mass for that intention during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. This is something that we as priests take very seriously because we are bound by canon law, and you have given a stipend to apply that intention to that particular Mass. We appreciate your cooperation in this sacred and delicate process where, as a community of faith, we raise our eyes to heaven to pray for our loved ones in the great celebration of the Eucharist. There at the altar we are united with all the saints in the heavenly realm and pray that our loved ones also enjoy the fruits of the Kingdom that our Lord has prepared for us.

Happy All Saints Day!

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

Al reunirnos en este domingo de víspera de la Fiesta de Todos los Santos, pensamos en la solemnidad que celebramos mañana, día de Todos los Santos, y la conmemoración de los fieles difuntos que celebramos al día siguiente. Recordamos que todos estamos llamados a ser santos, y que, como buenos cristianos, tenemos la obligación de orar por nuestros seres queridos fallecidos y por todos los que han muerto.

La tradición católica de ofrecer misas por nuestros seres queridos, especialmente aquellos que han muerto, se remonta a los inicios de la Iglesia Católica. En la Eucaristía estamos unidos de una manera única con los fieles difuntos y la Comunión de los Santos. ¿Por qué ofrecemos misas para nuestros seres queridos? Miremos al Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica: "Los que mueren en la gracia y en la amistad de Dios, pero imperfectamente purificados, aunque están seguros de su eterna salvación, sufren después de su muerte una purificación, a fin de obtener la santidad necesaria para entrar en la alegría del cielo. (1030)." Nuestras oraciones les ayudan a alcanzar las glorias del cielo y la oración perfecta es la Misa. El Papa León XIII nos recordó hace más de un siglo que si nuestros seres queridos ya han logrado su recompensa eterna, rezan por nosotros durante la Misa en un "intercambio mutuo" de oración. Orar por los muertos es también una de las obras espirituales de misericordia.

Ofrecer misas es una parte importante de nuestra tradición, ya que también se pueden ofrecer en acción de gracias por la salud de un ser querido y por intenciones especiales. Es un honor y un deber para mí y para mis hermanos sacerdotes de la parroquia ofrecer estas intenciones durante el Sacrificio de la Misa como parte de nuestro ministerio sacerdotal. Somos bendecidos en esta parroquia porque ofrecemos muchas intenciones

semanalmente durante nuestras misas diarias y dominicales que son apartadas por nuestros fieles. Nuestro personal en la oficina parroquial hace un trabajo ejemplar en la organización de las intenciones de la Misa con el cuidado sagrado que merecen.

El miércoles, 10 de noviembre, comenzaremos a reservar las intenciones para las Misas del 2022. Si desea ofrecer una misa en el aniversario de la muerte o el cumpleaños de un ser querido, le pedimos amablemente que lo haga con mucha anticipación. La ofrenda de una misa es un acto sagrado quemerece nuestra atención y cuidado, por lo que le pedimos que llame a nuestra oficina o que lo haga en persona en la oficina temprano para evitar cualquier error. Recuerde siempre que el sacerdote, incluso si no dice explícitamente el nombre del difunto o de la intención, todavía está ofreciendo la Misa por esa intención durante el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa. Esto es algo que nosotros, como sacerdotes, nos tomamos muy en serio porque estamos obligados por el derecho canónico, y usted ha dado un estipendio para aplicar esa intención a esa Misa en particular. Agradecemos su cooperación en este sagrado y delicado proceso donde, como comunidad de fe, elevamos nuestros ojos al cielo para orar por nuestros seres queridos en la gran celebración de la Eucaristía. Allí, en el altar, estamos unidos con todos los santos en el reino celestial y oramos para que nuestros seres queridos también disfruten de los frutos del Reino que nuestro Señor ha preparado para nosotros.

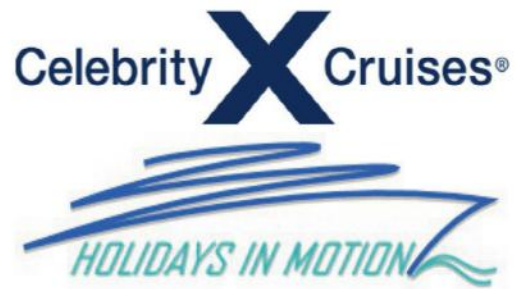
