



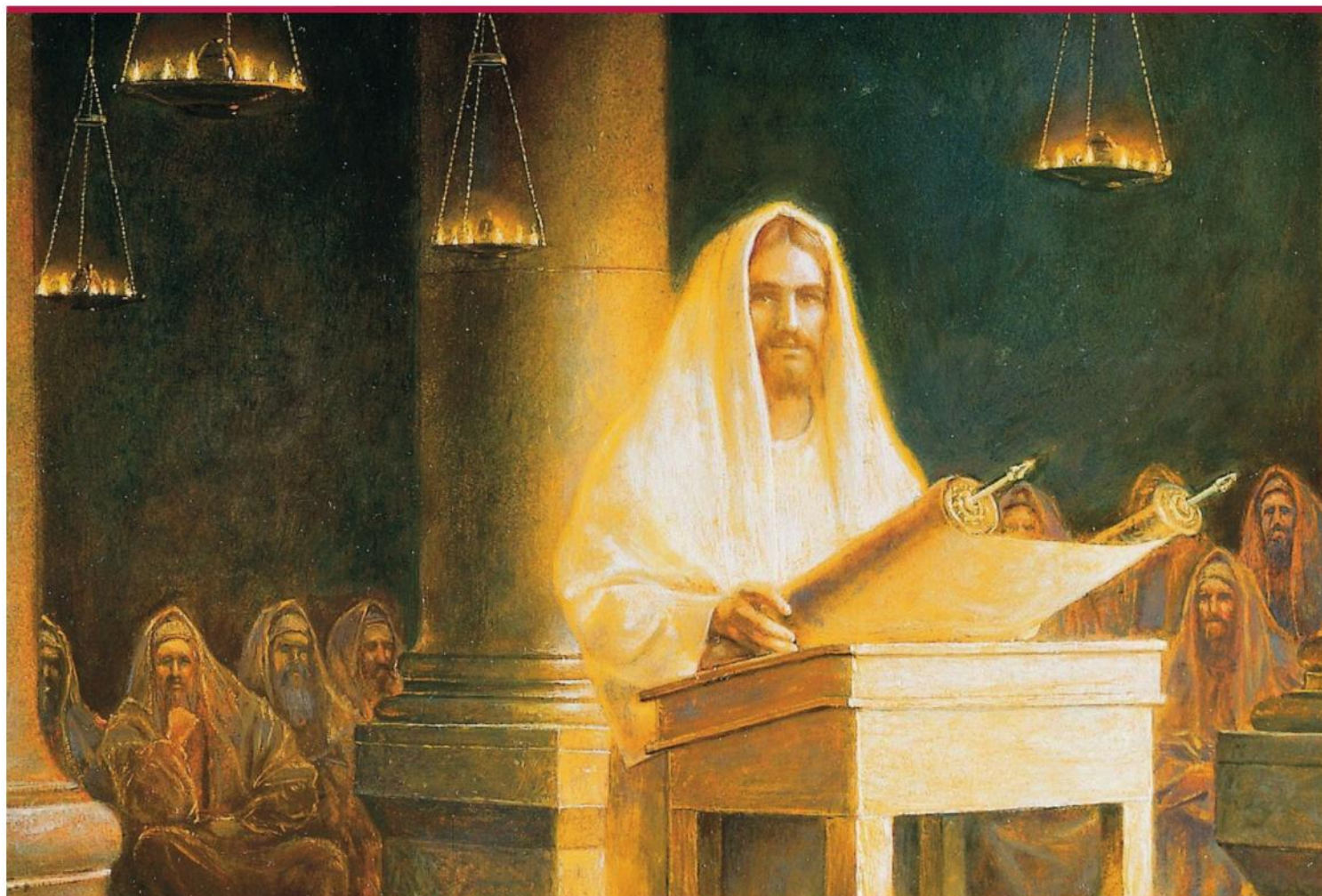

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

Last weekend I returned from my 7th March for Life in Washington, D.C. with the young people of the Archdiocese and 19 pilgrims from our parish. It was a truly blessed event that had the gift of snow falling during the actual March. Since *Roe v. Wade* was overturned 18 months ago, the last two Marches have taken on a joyful tone by our young people, but it comes with the conviction that still more work must be done so that abortion becomes unthinkable in this country.

One of the things that always strikes me in every March for Life and the activities that surround the March is the extraordinary faith of young Catholics in our country. Many travel by bus from remote parts of the Midwest or northeast through adverse conditions just to get to DC, participate in the March, and then hop right back on the bus to go home. On the morning of the March, we participated in LifeFest which is a morning of praise, witness, and Mass hosted by the Sisters of Life who are some of the most joy-filled nuns you will ever meet (after our own Carmelite Sisters, of course). About a hundred priests were in attendance which was providential because there were a lot of kids who wanted to go to confession. After confession, I was talking to a young man who told me he had traveled from somewhere in Nebraska and that they traveled 23 hours by bus. When I asked him if they made a stop along the way, he responded very innocently, "Oh yeah, Father, we stopped in gas stations along the way." I really meant if they stopped in a hotel to break up the trip, and he just smiled when I said that. They truly went on a long, sacrificial pilgrimage through the snow and sub-freezing temperatures to be able to get to our nation's capital to witness to life.

A couple of weeks ago, someone pointed out to me the Church's dwindling numbers. I quickly responded that the Church actually grew in 2023, our parish is about to receive a record number of Catechumens into the Church this Easter, and that our Mass attendance has increased since the pandemic. I forgot to tell this person that every January I witness hundreds of thousands of young Catholics marching for life in frigid temperatures on fire with the Holy Spirit. It should be noted that those who like to point out the Church's demise are people that are usually at odds with the Church. This was evident in Washington as we found several billboards throughout town put up by pro-abortion groups questioning our presence in DC and asking our young people if they came there out of conviction or because they got time off from school.

When you stand up for something bold, there will be many who will try to bring you down. Thankfully our young people did not encounter counter-protesters. We went in peace. We marched, we prayed, we sang, and with great joy, we even got into snowball fights before and after the March because what else are young Miamians going to do when surrounded by 6 inches of snow?

It is this joy and conviction that I witnessed in our young people that I pray spread throughout our community. We are so proud of these young Catholics because despite everything the world tells them, they still stand up for Christ, for their faith, and for the defense of human life from conception to natural death. Their courageous witness inspires me as their pastor and should inspire all of us to pray and work tirelessly for the unborn and to defend all human life.

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis queridos amigos,

El fin de semana pasado regresé de mi 7ª Marcha por la Vida en Washington, D.C. con los jóvenes de la Arquidiócesis y 19 peregrinos de nuestra parroquia. Fue un evento verdaderamente bendecido que tuvo el regalo de la nieve que cayó durante el mes de marzo. Desde que Roe v. Wade fue anulada hace 18 meses, las últimas dos marchas han tomado un tono alegre por parte de nuestros jóvenes, pero viene con la convicción de que aún se debe trabajar más para que el aborto se vuelva impensable en este país.

Una de las cosas que siempre me llama la atención en cada Marcha por la Vida y en las actividades que rodean la Marcha es la extraordinaria fe de los jóvenes católicos en nuestro país. Muchos viajan en autobús desde partes remotas del Medio Oeste o el noreste a través de condiciones adversas solo para llegar a DC para participar en la Marcha y luego volver a subirse al autobús para volver a casa. En la mañana de la Marcha, participamos en LifeFest, que es una mañana de alabanza, testimonio y Misa organizada por las Hermanas de la Vida, que son algunas de las monjas más llenas de alegría que todos conocerán (después de nuestras propias Hermanas Carmelitas, por supuesto). Asistieron alrededor de un centenar de sacerdotes, lo cual fue providencial porque había muchos niños que querían confesarse. Después de la confesión, estaba hablando con un joven que me dijo que había viajado desde algún lugar de Nebraska y que viajaron 23 horas en autobús. Cuando le pregunté si habían hecho una parada en el camino, respondió con mucha inocencia: "Oh, sí, padre, nos detuvimos en gasolineras en el camino". Realmente quise decir si se detenían en un hotel para interrumpir el viaje, y él solo sonrió cuando dije eso. Realmente emprendieron una larga y sacrificada peregrinación a través de la nieve y las temperaturas bajo cero para poder llegar a la capital de nuestra nación para dar testimonio de la vida.

Hace un par de semanas, alguien me señaló la disminución del número de miembros de la Iglesia. Rápidamente respondí que la Iglesia en realidad creció en 2023, que nuestra parroquia está a punto de recibir un número récord de catecúmenos en la Iglesia esta Pascua y que nuestra asistencia a Misa ha aumentado desde la pandemia. Olvidé decirle a esta persona que cada enero soy testigo de cientos de miles de jóvenes católicos marchando por la vida en temperaturas gélidas sobre el fuego del Espíritu Santo. Cabe señalar que aquellos a quienes les gusta señalar la desaparición de la Iglesia son personas que suelen estar en desacuerdo con la Iglesia. Esto fue evidente en Washington, ya que encontramos varias publicitarias en toda la ciudad colocadas por grupos proaborto que cuestionaban nuestra presencia en DC y preguntaban a nuestros jóvenes si habían venido allí por convicción o porque tenían tiempo libre en la escuela.

Cuando defiendas algo audaz, habrán muchos que tratarán de derribarte. Afortunadamente, nuestros jóvenes no se encontraron con contra manifestantes. Fuimos en paz. Marchamos, rezamos, cantamos y, con mucha alegría, incluso nos metimos en peleas de bolas de nieve antes y después de la marcha, porque ¿qué más van a hacer los jóvenes Miamenses cuando están rodeados de 6 pulgadas de nieve?

Es esta alegría y convicción que presencié en nuestros jóvenes lo que rezo para que se extienda por toda nuestra comunidad. Estamos muy orgullosos de estos jóvenes católicos porque, a pesar de todo lo que el mundo les dice, siguen defendiendo a Cristo, su fe y la defensa de la vida humana desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural. Su valiente testimonio me inspira como su pastor y debe inspirarnos a todos a orar y trabajar incansablemente por los que no han nacido y a defender toda vida humana.

Temporary Organ and Balcony Update

The church might look a little different than you're used to!

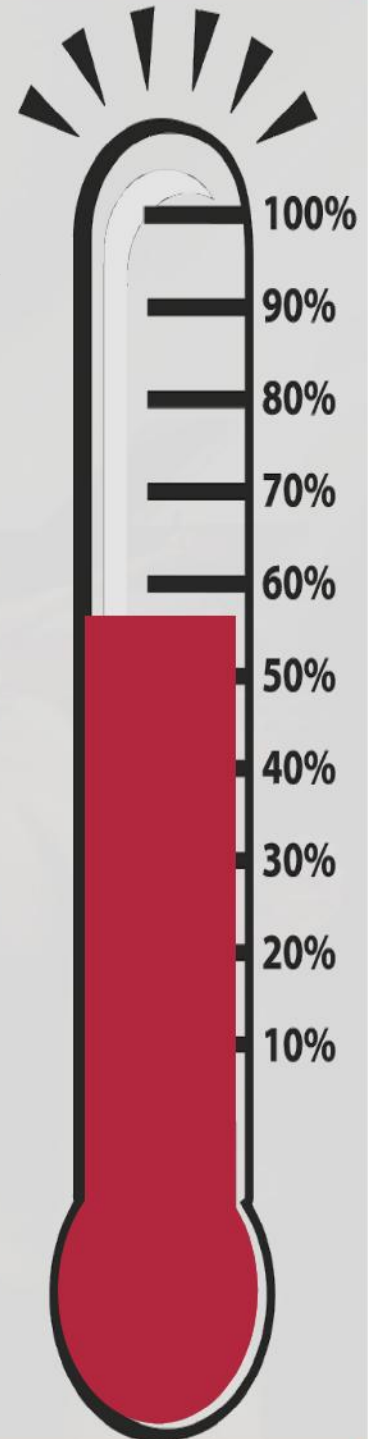
The old choir loft has now been removed to make way for more pew seating on the floor level and our entire music ministry has now been relocated to the balcony. Over these next two years as our new pipe organ is being built, we will be making use of a smaller, temporary organ, which you'll be hearing for the first time today.

As the music plays and the choir sings, close your eyes for a minute and take notice of how the sound coming from behind you propels you forward toward the sanctuary and invites you to join together in singing. This temporary arrangement of the music ministry is a small foretaste of what we can expect when the new pipe organ is installed and the music and sound is not being pumped through speakers but rather is generated by wind physically moving through the pipes and making them sing. The pipe organ reminds us very clearly of how the Holy Spirit moves and acts through us, making us come alive and "sing."

Consider how the Holy Spirit may be moving you this weekend.

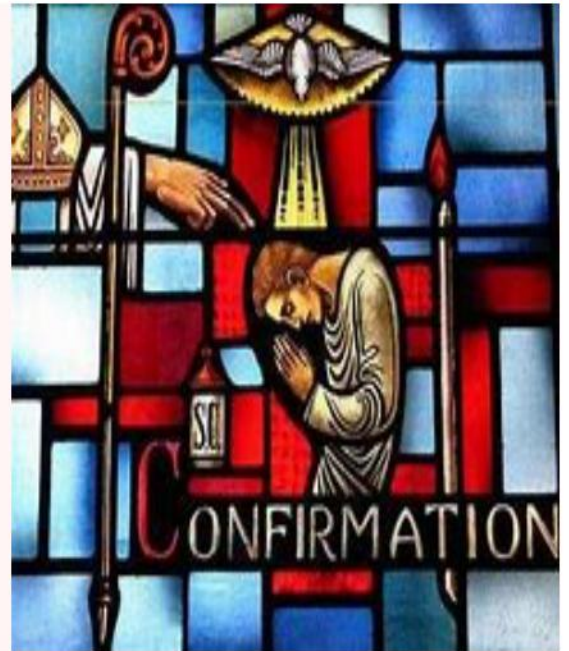


ST. THERESA SCHOOL CONFIRMATION MASS

ST. BLAISE AND THE BLESSING OF THROATS

February 3rd is the Memorial of St. Blaise, a 4th Century Bishop who was martyred for his faith in Jesus Christ. According to tradition, St. Blaise is most well known for the miraculous healing of a boy who was choking to death from a fish bone that had become lodged in his throat. St. Blaise prayed over the boy and he was healed.

Over the centuries, a tradition developed within the church for the faithful to have their throats blessed on this day in which we celebrate St. Blaise. The priest, holding two blessed candles in the form of an X, usually tied with a red ribbon to represent the blood of the martyrs, touches the candles to each side of the person's neck and prays:

"Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

The annual blessing of throats will take place following the 8:00am morning Mass on Saturday, February 3rd.

Actualización del Proyecto del Órgano y del Balcón de la Iglesia

El antiguo coro ha sido removido para dar paso a más bancos en el nivel del piso y todo nuestro ministerio de música ha sido reubicado en el balcón. Durante estos próximos dos años, a medida que se construya nuestro nuevo órgano de tubos, haremos uso de un órgano temporal más pequeño, que escucharán por primera vez hoy.

Mientras suena la música y canta el coro, cierra los ojos por un minuto y observa cómo el sonido que viene detrás de ti te impulsa hacia el santuario y te invita a unirse en el canto. 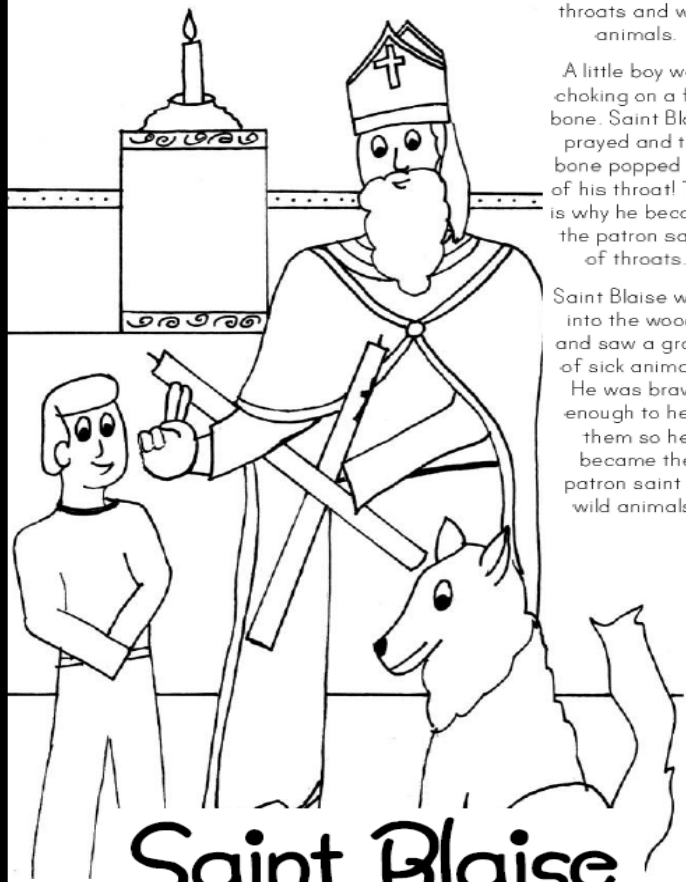

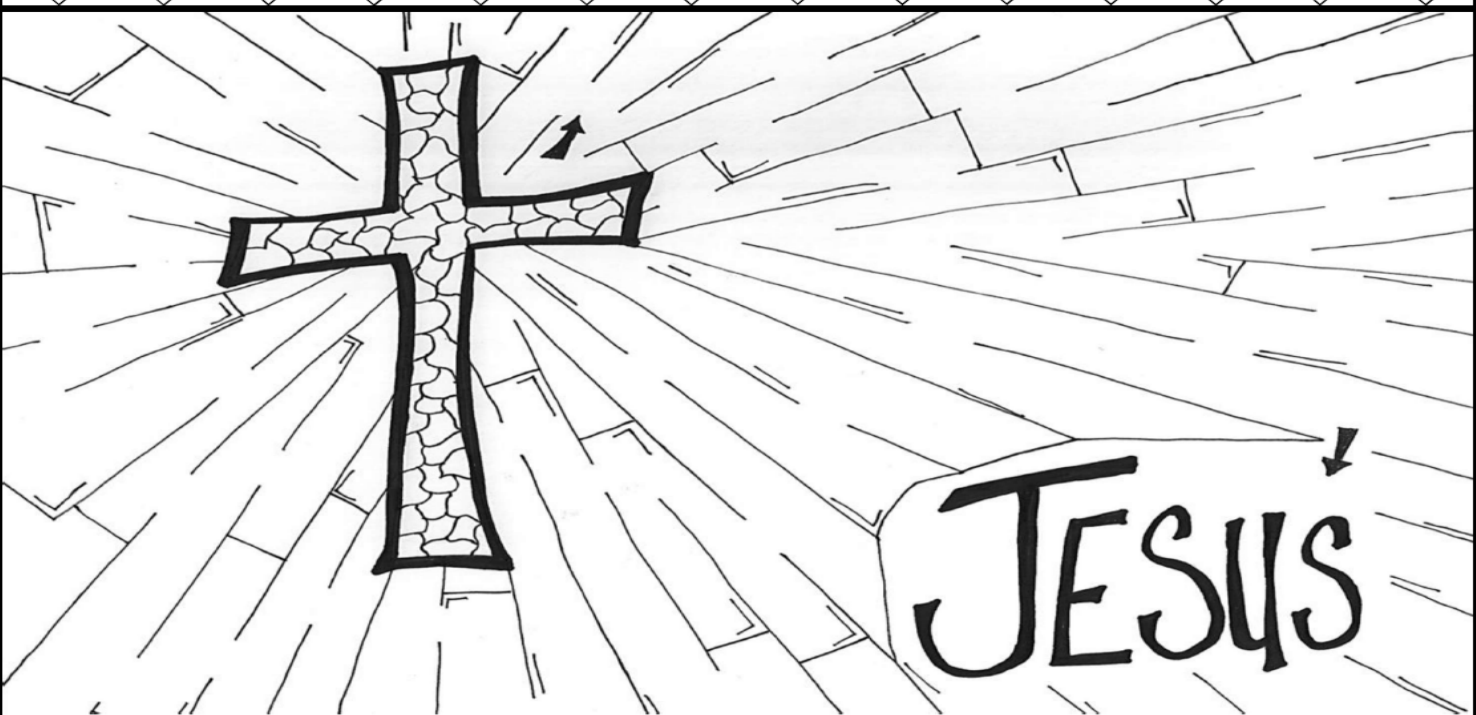
