



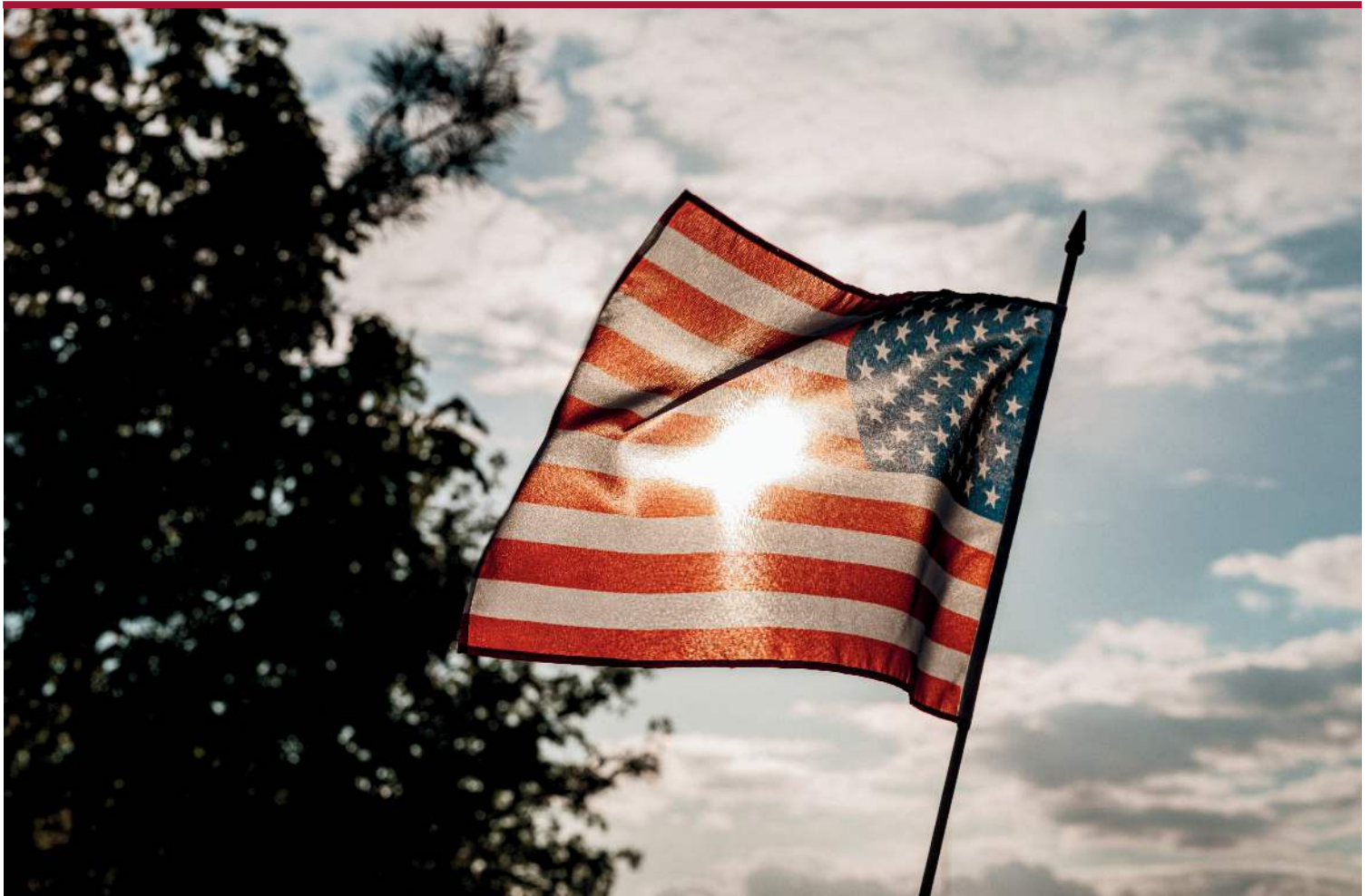

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends,

I am writing this column to you early in the week from the holy city of Lourdes just five minutes away from where the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Saint Bernadette almost 170 years ago. By the time you read this, I will be back in the parish to celebrate the Fourth of July with all of you. More on that below.

As I write this, we are concluding our Centennial pilgrimage that took us last weekend to the city of our patroness in Lisieux. How I wish I could have had the entire parish with us in the Basilica of St. Therese to renew our commitment as a parish to evangelize and to live holy lives as our patroness calls us to live as we bring our Centennial year to close in the next few months. One of the surprising things that struck me at the beginning of the pilgrimage was when we visited the birthplace of St. Therese in Alençon. There you get an in-depth look into the lives of her parents, St. Louis and St. Zélie whose feast day we celebrate on July 12. St. Zélie died of breast cancer when Therese was only 4, yet as a mother she prayed every day that her children may achieve sainthood. Her prayers from 150 years ago should soon be answered as all her children are on paths towards canonization. What struck me was this: that this mother prayed so fervently for her children to gain heaven. That was in the heart of St. Louis as well. They already have one child who has been canonized and soon will have more God willing. So, I ask the mothers and the fathers of our parish, do you pray every day that your children may be saints? That is at the core of your vocation as a Christian mother and father.

Last weekend, I celebrated Mass and spent much time in prayer in the Basilica of St. Therese. Our pilgrims lit many candles, but I only lit one candle where the relics that visited us back in December are permanently housed. My prayer was simply for our parish: that we may grow in holiness, that we may grow more and more in love with the Lord, that we may lead others to Christ and to his Blessed Mother, and that we focus solely on Jesus who is present every day at our altar.

Everything else that we do as a parish and as a school flows from that transformative encounter we have at the altar every time we approach our Lord in Holy Communion.

From Lisieux we traveled south to Lourdes. This is where I am writing these lines acutely aware that the only thing that should matter to us is our relationship with Jesus and to keep the Blessed Virgin Mary very close to us as a prayer companion, as an intercessor, and as a mother who protects us and loves us as she loves her son. I have seen many groups numbering in the hundreds, particularly from Ireland, the homeland of our founding pastor, and what brought me joy was seeing so many young people. I prayed that Ireland, which produced so many missionaries that founded our diocese, may be going through somewhat of a spiritual renaissance. And so, I sat in the square in front of the Basilica of Lourdes and saw all these people taking group photos and dreamed of taking a great number of you to these holy places one day, and I continued to pray for you at the feet of Our Lady. There was a singular purpose and a singular petition that I prayed for over and over again during this pilgrimage: for the sanctification of my parish.

Now I return to join you in celebrating the semiquincentennial of our great nation this weekend. How blessed are we that we get to mark this milestone in the life of our country! Since I am writing this in Lourdes, I cannot help but think of what Mary told St. Bernadette: "I am the Immaculate Conception." She just happens to be the patroness of the United States of America. May our Blessed Mother protect our nation and may we all help build a more perfect union by simply being saints.

God bless all of you, my holy people.*

DEL ESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

Os escribo esta columna a principios de semana desde la ciudad santa de Lourdes, a solo cinco minutos de donde la Santísima Virgen María se apareció a Santa Bernadette hace casi 170 años. Cuando leáis esto, estaré de vuelta en la parroquia para celebrar el 4 de julio con todos vosotros. Más sobre eso más abajo.

Mientras escribo esto, concluimos nuestra peregrinación del Centenario que nos llevó el pasado fin de semana a la ciudad de nuestra patrona en Lisieux. Cómo desearía haber podido contar con toda la parroquia con nosotros en la Basílica de Santa Teresa para renovar nuestro compromiso como parroquia de evangelizar y vivir vidas santas como nuestra patrona nos llama a vivir mientras cerramos nuestro año del centenario en los próximos meses. Una de las cosas que me sorprendió al principio de la peregrinación fue cuando visitamos el lugar de nacimiento de Santa Teresa en Alençon. Allí se obtiene una mirada en profundidad a la vida de sus padres, St. Louis y St. Zélie, cuya festividad celebramos el 12 de julio. Santa Zélie murió de cáncer de mama cuando Therese tenía solo 4 años, pero como madre rezaba cada día para que sus hijos pudieran alcanzar la santidad. Sus plegarias de hace 150 años deberían ser pronto respondidas, ya que todos sus hijos están en caminos hacia la canonización. Lo que me llamó la atención fue esto: que esta madre rezaba con tanta fervor para que sus hijos alcanzaran el cielo. Eso también fue en el corazón de St. Louis. Ya tienen un hijo que ha sido canonizado y pronto tendrá más si Dios quiere. Así que pregunto a las madres y padres de nuestra parroquia: ¿rezáis todos los días para que vuestros hijos sean santos? Eso está en el núcleo de tu vocación como madre y padre cristianos.

El pasado fin de semana celebré misa y pasé mucho tiempo en oración en la Basílica de Santa Teresa. Nuestros peregrinos encendieron muchas velas, pero yo solo encendí una vela donde las reliquias que nos visitaron en diciembre están guardadas de forma permanente. Mi oración era simplemente por nuestra parroquia: para que crezcamos en santidad, para que nos enamoremos cada vez más del Señor, para que podamos guiar a otros hacia Cristo y hacia su Santísima Madre, y para que nos centremos

únicamente en Jesús, que está presente cada día en nuestro altar. Todo lo demás que hacemos como parroquia y como escuela surge de ese encuentro transformador que tenemos en el altar cada vez que nos acercamos a nuestro Señor en la Sagrada Comunión.

Desde Lisieux viajamos hacia el sur, hasta Lourdes. Aquí es donde escribo estas líneas muy consciente de que lo único que debería importarnos es nuestra relación con Jesús y mantener a la Santísima Virgen María muy cerca de nosotros como compañera de oración, como intercesora y como madre que nos protege y nos ama como ama a su hijo. He visto muchos grupos que se cuentan por cientos, especialmente de Irlanda, la tierra natal de nuestro pastor fundador, y lo que me alegró fue ver a tantos jóvenes. Recé para que Irlanda, que produjo tantos misioneros que fundaron nuestra diócesis, estuviera atravesando una especie de renacimiento espiritual. Así que me senté en la plaza frente a la Basílica de Lourdes y vi a toda esa gente haciendo fotos de grupo y soñé con llevar a un gran número de vosotros a estos lugares santos algún día, y seguí rezando por vosotros a los pies de Nuestra Señora. Había un propósito y una petición singulares por la que recé una y otra vez durante esta peregrinación: la santificación de mi parroquia.

Ahora regreso para unirme a vosotros en la celebración del semiquincuésimo aniversario de nuestra gran nación este fin de semana. ¡Qué afortunados somos de poder marcar este hito en la vida de nuestro país! Como escribo esto en Lourdes, no puedo evitar pensar en lo que María le dijo a Santa Bernardeta: "Yo soy la Inmaculada Concepción." Resulta que es la patrona de los Estados Unidos de América. Que nuestra Santísima Virgen proteja nuestra nación y que todos podamos ayudar a construir una unión más perfecta simplemente siendo santos.

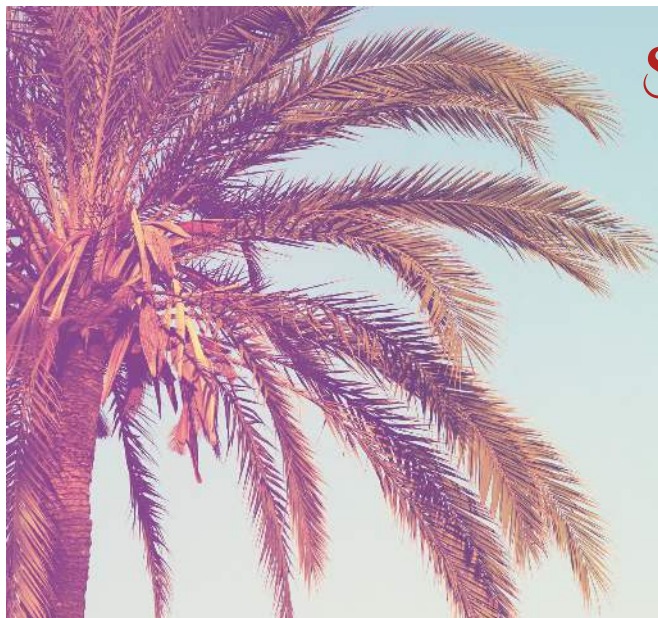
ORGAN VOICING CONTINUES

Over the next four months, the team from CB Fisk will be on site every day to continue the tedious work of voicing and tuning the organ.

As beautiful as the organ currently sounds, it is still only about 40% voiced!

Due to the delicate nature of the work and the need for silence in the space while each individual pipe is tuned properly, the church will be generally closed Monday - Friday from 11:00am through 5:00pm until late September.

The team is working to have the organ completed in time for our Centennial Mass on Saturday, October 3rd and the Dedication Concert on Saturday, October 24th

PIPE ORGANS ARE FOREVER... AND NOW YOUR LEGACY CAN BE, TOO!

Each one our Pipe Organ's 3,035 pipes were meticulously hand-crafted at the CB Fisk workshop in Gloucester, MA. From the melting of the metals and the creation of large tin sheets to the precise measuring, cutting, rolling, soldering, and detailed finishing, each pipe itself is a masterful work of art.

The pipes from Opus 166 are specially available to be dedicated in memory of a loved one, to commemorate major milestones like baptisms, first communions, confirmations, graduations, birthdays, weddings, or anniversaries, or simply to add your family's name to the long legacy of our parish in this milestone year.

Pipe Memorializations will be recorded in a specially printed booklet which will be provided to each donor at no additional cost early next year. A copy of the booklet will also remain inside the organ in perpetuity, ensuring the lasting legacy of both the instrument itself and of all those who helped to make it possible.

Interior pipes are available for dedication at \$300 each and facade pipes, forever visible on the front of each of the organ's three major cases, are available for \$1,000 each.

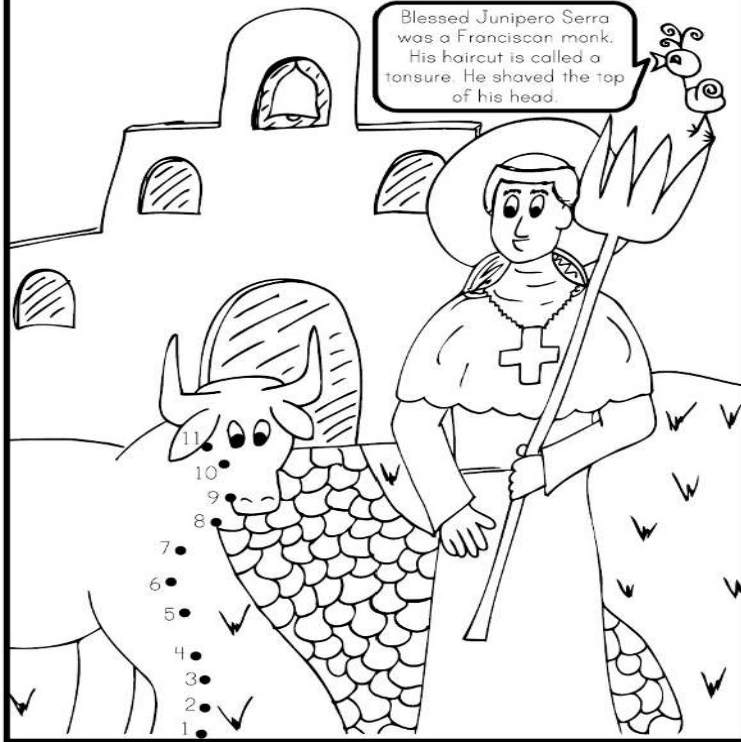


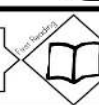

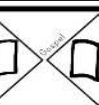
Saint Junipero Serra

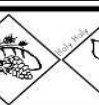
Saint Junipero Serra grew up in Spain, then became a missionary and traveled to the United States. He built missions and taught people about farming, cattle ranching, and Jesus.

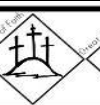
Blessed Junipero Serra was a Franciscan monk. His haircut is called a tonsure. He shaved the top of his head.



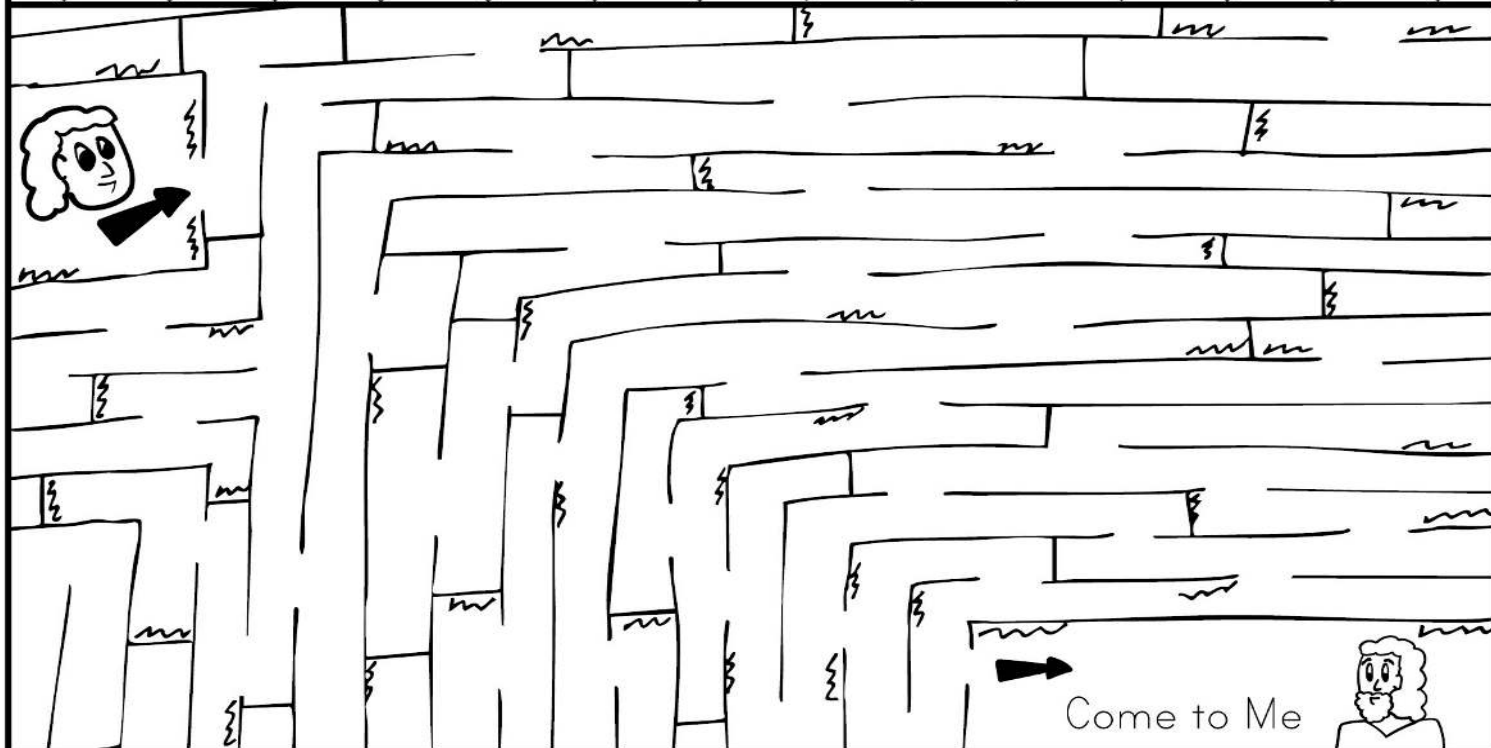
