MAGNIFICA HUMANITAS

Throughout this summer, we encourage all parishioners to read the Encyclical Letter, Magnifica Humanitas, of Pope Leo XIV, on safeguarding the human person in the time of Artificial Intelligence. Over the next several weeks, we will be publishing excerpts from the encyclical for further reflection. The encyclical in its entirety may be found on the Vatican website or you can purchase a physical copy of letter at your preferred religious bookstore or retailer.

11. Building a city founded on the common good implies, first and foremost, building on a firm relationship with God. It means recognizing that the truth of his love calls us to life “in all its fullness” (Jn 10:10) and communion with him. Like Saint Augustine, we too can say, “You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our heart is restless until it rests in you.” [8] Indeed, God has inscribed in our hearts a desire for happiness that embraces all the dimensions of life. The Church, in dialogue with the men and women of our time, recognizes the urgent need to safeguard and guide this aspiration toward its deepest truth.

12. Secondly, building for the common good means accepting the limits and weakness of humanity without considering them an error to be corrected. Today, the human desire for fullness of life is at risk of being misled by deceitful goals, such as the prospect of a technology that promises to free us from all weakness, and models of wellbeing that leave behind entire populations. All too often, we place our hope in unlimited “upgrades,” in forms of progress that exacerbate inequalities, and in immediate solutions incapable of healing people’s wounds. As a result, while some pursue the illusion of unlimited self-assertion, many are deprived of basic necessities.

The Church reminds us, with a firm yet humble voice, that true fulfilment is not achieved by eliminating weakness but through harmonious growth. It is found where freedom and responsibility are intertwined with mutual care and true solidarity, and where progress is measured by the dignity of each person and the good of all peoples.

13. Thirdly, building a world in which everyone can flourish requires shared responsibility and courage. No one can single-handedly bear the weight of the challenges the world is facing, just as no one is so weak that they cannot play their part, for “power is made perfect in weakness” (2 Cor 12:9). All are given their own section of the wall: scientists and researchers, entrepreneurs and workers, educators and legislators, civil society, popular movements and faith communities. This is the logic of subsidiarity, which values the cooperation between generations, peoples, disciplines and cultures as the best way for fostering stability, prosperity and peace. We should not be intimidated by tensions or differences because they can become creative forces when guided by shared responsibility.

14. Finally, building for the common good requires an evangelical language. We must avoid humiliating or antagonistic words, opting rather for a clarity that sheds light and a frankness that unlocks new possibilities. We cannot condone naïve enthusiasms, nor fuel unfounded fears. Instead, let us establish standards for discernment — the dignity of the human person, the universal destination of goods, the preferential option for the poor, care for our common home and peace — and let us translate these standards into practices such as responsible planning, the assessment of human and social impact, the inclusion of the most vulnerable, the promotion of digital literacy and guiding research and industry toward justice and peace.



MAGNIFICA HUMANITAS

A lo largo de este verano, animamos a todos los feligreses a leer la Carta Encíclica, Magnífica Humanitas, del Papa León XIV, sobre la salvaguarda de la persona humana en la era de la Inteligencia Artificial. Durante las próximas semanas, publicaremos extractos de la encíclica para una mayor reflexión. La encíclica en su totalidad se puede encontrar en el sitio web del Vaticano o puede comprar una copia física de la carta en su librería religiosa o distribuidor preferido.

11. Edificar una ciudad centrada en el bien común exige, ante todo, edificar sobre la roca de la relación con Dios. Significa reconocer que la verdad de su amor nos llama a una vida «en abundancia» (Jn 10,10) y a la comunión con Él. Junto con san Agustín, también nosotros podemos decir: «Porque nos has hecho para ti y nuestro corazón está inquieto hasta que descanse en ti». [8] En efecto, Dios ha inscrito en nuestro corazón un deseo de felicidad que abraza todas las dimensiones de la vida; y la Iglesia, en el diálogo con los hombres y las mujeres de nuestro tiempo, siente la urgencia de custodiar y orientar esa aspiración hacia su verdad más profunda.

12. En segundo lugar, edificar en el bien significa aceptar los límites y la fragilidad de la humanidad sin considerarlos un error que haya que corregir. Hoy en día, el deseo de plenitud del ser humano corre el riesgo de desviarse hacia metas engañosas: la ilusión de una tecnología que promete liberarnos de toda fragilidad o modelos de bienestar que “dejan atrás” a pueblos enteros. No es raro que pongamos nuestra esperanza en un potencial ilimitado, en formas de progreso que pueden agudizar las desigualdades, en soluciones inmediatas incapaces de sanar las heridas de los pueblos. Así, mientras algunos persiguen la quimera de una autoafirmación ilimitada, muchos carecen de lo necesario.

La Iglesia recuerda, con voz humilde pero firme, que la verdadera realización no nace de la eliminación de las fragilidades, sino de un crecimiento armonioso: allí donde la libertad y la responsabilidad se entrelazan con el cuidado recíproco y la verdadera solidaridad, y donde el progreso se mide por la dignidad de cada uno y por el bien de los pueblos.

13. En tercer lugar, edificar un mundo en el que todos puedan “florecer” exige una corresponsabilidad valiente. Ninguna mano, por sí sola, basta para sostener el peso de los desafíos que atraviesa el mundo; y ninguna es tan débil como para no poder ofrecer su contribución: «Mi poder triunfa en la debilidad» (2 Co 12,9). A cada uno corresponde su tramo de muralla: científicos e investigadores, empresarios y trabajadores, educadores y legisladores, sociedad civil, movimientos populares y comunidades de fe. Esta es la lógica de la subsidiariedad, que valora la cooperación entre generaciones, entre pueblos, entre disciplinas y culturas como el camino privilegiado para hacer crecer la estabilidad, la prosperidad y la paz. Las tensiones y las diferencias no deben intimidar; pueden convertirse en energías creativas cuando están orientadas por una responsabilidad compartida.

14. Por último, edificar en el bien requiere un lenguaje evangélico. Evitemos las palabras que humillan o enfrentan. Optemos por la claridad que ilumina y la franqueza que abre caminos. No bendigamos entusiasmos ingenuos ni alimentemos miedos estériles. Más bien, indiquemos criterios de discernimiento —la dignidad de la persona, el destino universal de los bienes, la opción por los pobres, el cuidado de la Casa común, la paz— y traduzcámoslos en prácticas: planificación responsable, evaluaciones del impacto humano y social, inclusión de los más frágiles, alfabetización digital, investigación e industria orientadas a la justicia y la paz.

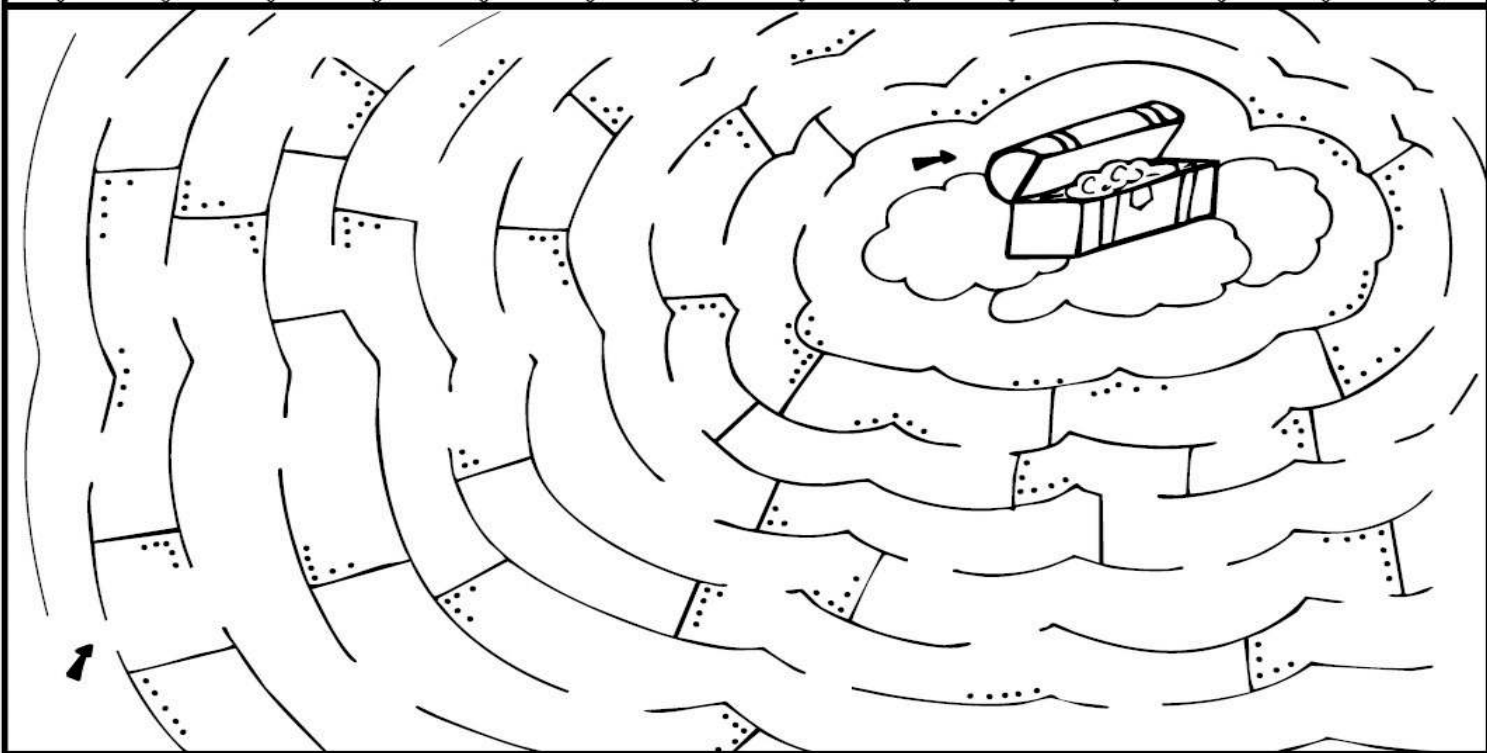
