FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My Dear Friends:

As Catholics, we grow up hearing heroic stories about martyrs who gave their lives for our faith and shed their blood in distant lands centuries ago. Martyrdom isn't something we think will come to our doorstep. Even today, we hear of Christians being slaughtered in places like Nigeria, where Fr. Uko and Fr. Stephen hail from, or even in Sri Lanka where Fr. Francis is from where a few years ago Catholics gathered for Easter Mass and were targeted in coordinated attacks. These are things we hear about happening "over there" but not here in America.

Twenty-five years ago, "over there" arrived on our doorstep, and we witnessed firsthand that martyrdom had arrived at our shores. Our world changed in an instant when innocent lives going about their day had their lives taken from them when terrorism arrived in a radical way to our country. What we witnessed in the aftermath of the attacks of September 11, 2001 was the rise of heroes and martyrs. We saw firefighters and first responders rushing into burning towers to save lives, only to give their lives instead at the service of their brothers and sisters. We saw a country united in their grief. No one could have possibly imagined that this would ever happen here on this continent. Even though it had happened at Pearl Harbor in 1941, that still seemed like "over there." It was time for a new generation to stand up and stand united as the greatest generation did during World War II.

While that unity was strong in the weeks and months after 9/11, sadly it did not last. Unity seems like a dream now. Divisiveness is the norm in our country today, and I dare say, even in the Church where I caution people constantly not to look at Church events and news through a political lense. Unity is what our Lord prayed for the night before he died.

Unity is what this solemn anniversary calls for. We constantly hear the refrain to never forget. Sadly, so many have indeed forgotten the sacrifices of those first responders who ran into the fire, or those first military men and women who enlisted on September 12th. We have forgotten what they taught us because they personified that radical love that Christ taught us: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends (John 15:13)."

So, as people of faith, we must take up the cause of unity and prayer. We are a great nation with a noble purpose. We are a nation that began with selfless men laying down their lives for the sake of liberty. That selflessness has come to the forefront again and again when history demanded it. But we seem to have lost our way, so we turn to those martyrs, who we pray are in heaven, to teach us to love as they loved. That is how we honor their memory and truly never forget the sacrifice they made and the unity that they inspired.

God of peace, bring your peace to our violent world: peace in the hearts of all men and women and peace among the nations of the earth. Turn to your way of love those whose hearts and minds are consumed with hatred. God of understanding, overwhelmed by the magnitude of this tragedy, we seek your light and guidance as we confront such terrible events. Grant that those whose lives were spared may live so that the lives lost here may not have been lost in vain. Comfort and console us, strengthen us in hope, and give us the wisdom and courage to work tirelessly for a world where true peace and love reign among nations and in the hearts of all. DELESCRITORIO DEL PARROCO

Mis Queridos Amigos,

Como católicos, crecemos escuchando historias heroicas sobre mártires que dieron su vida por nuestra fe y derramaron su sangre en tierras lejanas hace siglos. El martirio no es algo que pensemos que llegará a nuestra puerta. Incluso hoy, oímos hablar de cristianos masacrados en lugares como Nigeria, de donde son el padre Uko y el padre Stephen, o incluso en Sri Lanka, donde el padre Francis es de donde hace unos años los católicos se reunían para la misa de Pascua y eran objetivo de ataques coordinados. Estas son cosas que oímos que ocurren "allí", pero no aquí en Estados Unidos.

Hace veinticinco años, "allí" llegó a nuestra puerta y fuimos testigos directos de que el martirio había llegado a nuestras costas. Nuestro mundo cambió en un instante cuando vidas inocentes que seguían con su vida fueron arrebatadas cuando el terrorismo llegó radicalmente a nuestro país. Lo que presenciamos tras los ataques del 11 de septiembre de 2001 fue el ascenso de héroes y mártires. Vimos bomberos y primeros intervinientes irrumpiendo en torres en llamas para salvar vidas, solo para dar sus vidas al servicio de sus hermanos y hermanas. Vimos un país unido en su dolor. Nadie podría haber imaginado que esto ocurriría aquí en este continente. Aunque ocurrió en Pearl Harbor en 1941, eso seguía pareciendo "allí". Era hora de que una nueva generación se levantara y permaneciera unida como lo hizo la generación más grande durante la Segunda Guerra Mundial.

Aunque esa unidad fue fuerte en las semanas y meses posteriores al 11-S, lamentablemente no duró. La unidad parece ahora un sueño. La división es la norma en nuestro país hoy en día, y me atrevo a decir que incluso en la Iglesia, donde advierto constantemente a la gente que no vea los eventos y noticias de la Iglesia desde una perspectiva política. La unidad es por lo que nuestro Señor oró la noche antes de morir.

La unidad es lo que este solemne aniversario pide. Constantemente escuchamos el estribillo de no olvidar nunca. Lamentablemente, muchos han olvidado los sacrificios de aquellos primeros intervinientes que corrieron hacia el fuego, o de esos primeros hombres y mujeres militares que se alistaron el 12 de septiembre. Hemos olvidado lo que nos enseñaron porque personificaban ese amor radical que Cristo nos enseñó: "Nadie tiene mayor amor que este, dar la vida por los amigos (Juan 15:13)."

Así que, como personas de fe, debemos tomar la causa de la unidad y la oración. Somos una gran nación con un propósito noble. Somos una nación que comenzó con hombres desinteresados entregando sus vidas por la libertad. Ese altruismo ha salido a la luz una y otra vez cuando la historia lo exige. Pero parece que hemos perdido el rumbo, así que recurrimos a esos mártires, a quienes rezamos para que estén en el cielo, para que nos enseñen a amar como ellos amaban. Así es como honramos su memoria y nunca olvidamos de verdad el sacrificio que hicieron ni la unidad que inspiraron.

Dios de paz, trae tu paz a nuestro mundo violento: paz en los corazones de todos los hombres y mujeres y paz entre las naciones de la tierra. Vuelve a tu camino de amor a aquellos cuyos corazones y mentes están consumidos por el odio. Dios de entendimiento, abrumado por la magnitud de esta tragedia, buscamos tu luz y guía ante estos terribles acontecimientos. Concédete que aquellos cuyas vidas fueron perdonadas puedan vivir para que las vidas perdidas aquí no se hayan perdido en vano. Consuélanos y consuela, fortalecenos en la esperanza y danos la sabiduría y el valor para trabajar incansablemente por un mundo donde la verdadera paz y amor reinen entre las naciones y en los corazones de todos. 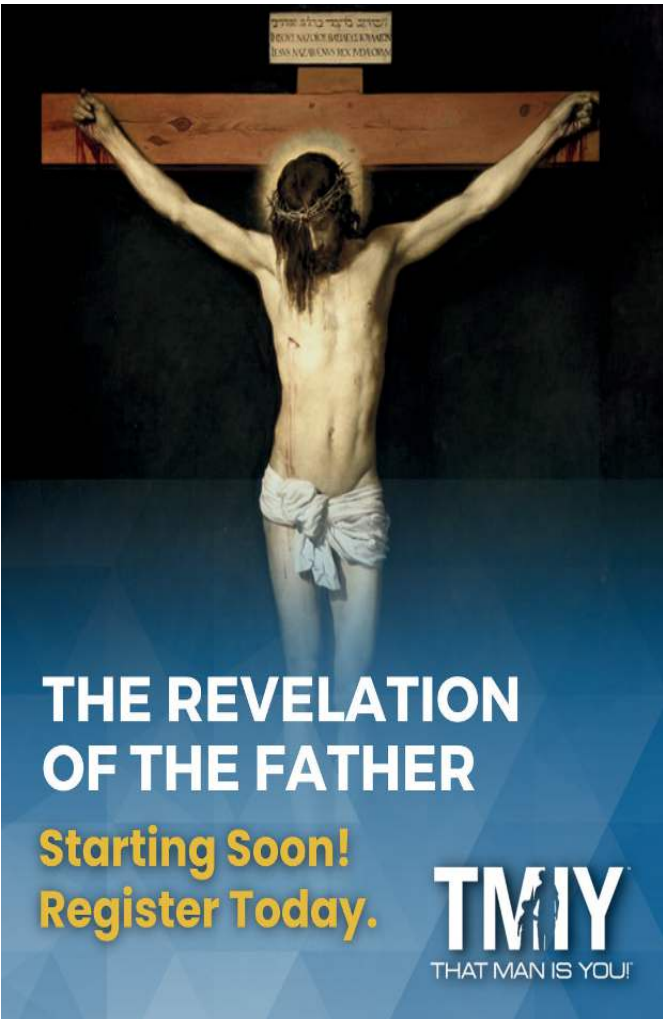

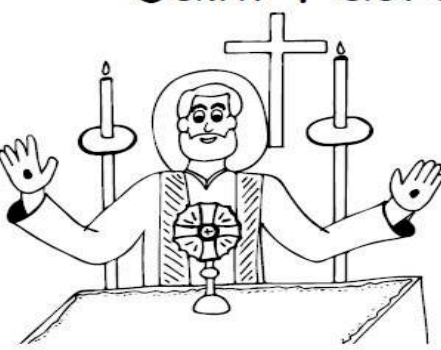
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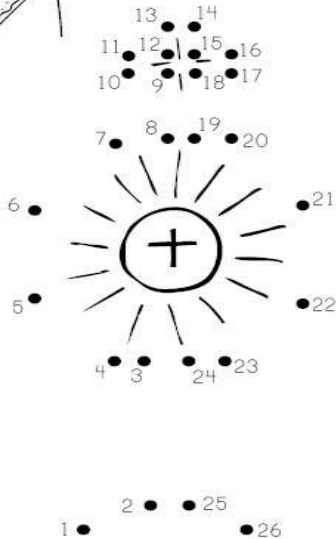

When people went to confession with him, he **KNEW** when they were forgetting something. He would help them remember so they could learn from all of their sins.







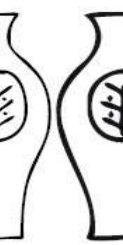
