We are inviting 18 couples into the Discernment year beginning in September. Please pray for these couples.

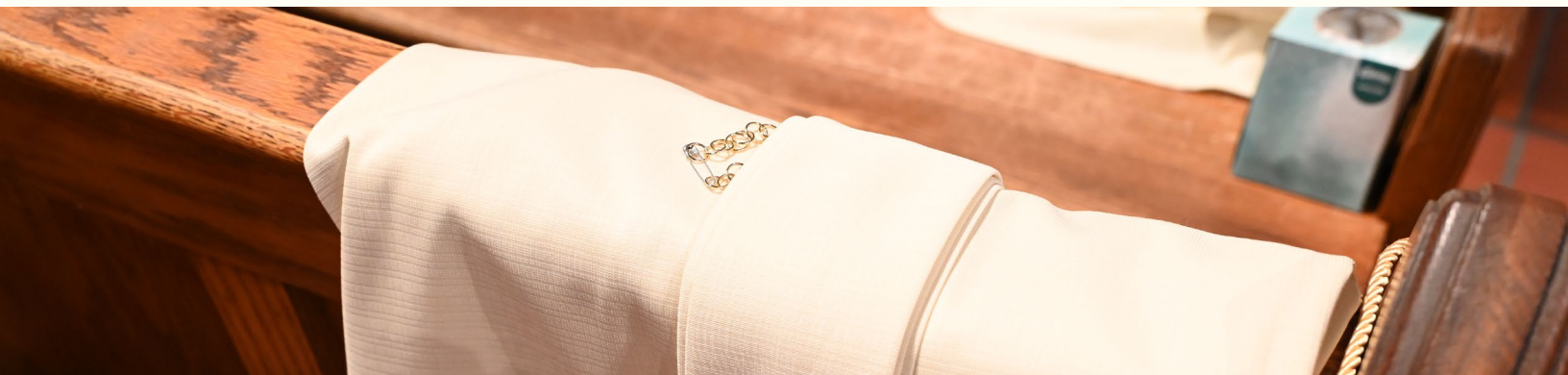
GOOD NEWS

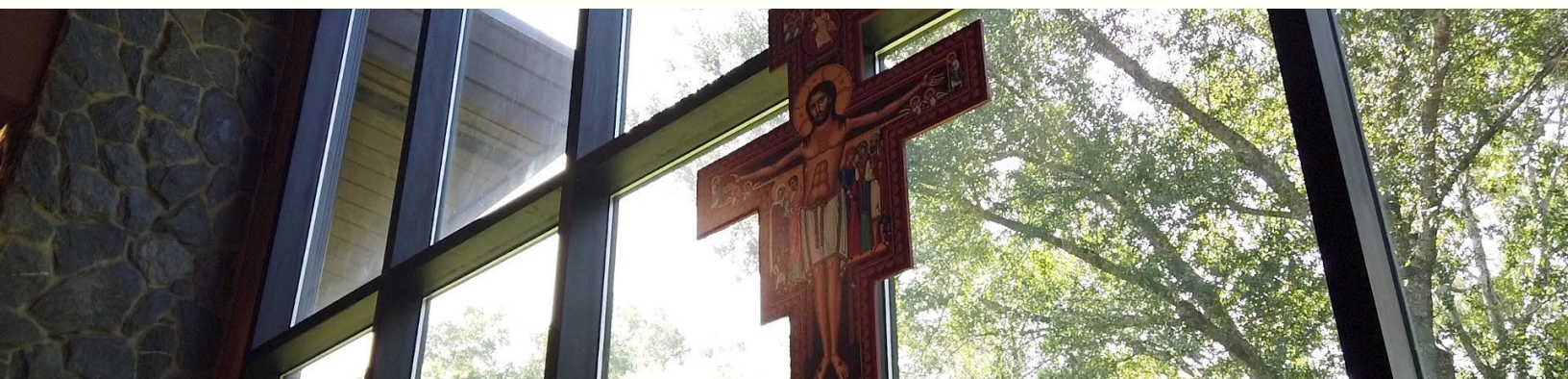

Single-Session Courses

Jesus Was a Refugee

LITURGY UPDATES & SEASONAL RESOURCES

FDLC

Two publishers have been chosen to print the four volumes of the Liturgy of the Hours – Ascension Press and Word on Fire.

- The publishers have announced that they will begin accepting pre-orders on July 1, 2026.
- The volumes will be released gradually.
- The first volume to ship will be Volume II – Lent and Easter seasons.
- Each volume will be shipped approximately one month before its permitted first use date.
- It is anticipated that digital and one volume editions will be available by the first Sunday of Advent 2028.
- Mandatory use for the revised translation of the Liturgy of the Hours is the first Sunday of Advent 2028.

JUNE 11, 2026: CONSECRATION OF THE COUNTRY TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

At the November 2025 Plenary Assembly, the Bishops of the United States voted to consecrate the USA to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, in recognition of the nation's 250th birthday. Details of the celebration were assigned to the Bishops' Committee for Religious Liberty.

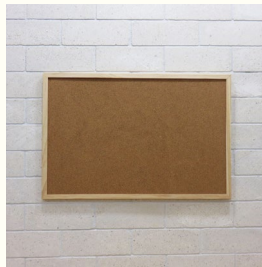
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
