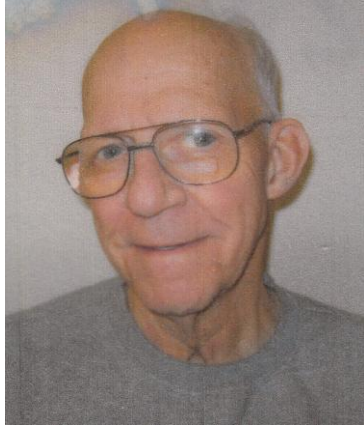




Carl David Krebs, Age 79 of Manistee died Friday evening December 16, 2016 at Munson Medical Center in Traverse City.
