

Robert A. "Bob" Mikula age 85 of Manistee, Michigan died Friday, October 29, 2010 at his home, unexpectedly. He was born March 29, 1925 in Filer Township, Michigan and was the son of the late Anthony and Sophie (Tabaka) Mikula.

As a young man Bob received his certification in Television Repair and for most of his life owned and operated his own television repair service in the Manistee area. He enjoyed being on the water in his boat, and loved to draw and paint, but one of his greatest talents and enjoyments came from his photography and darkroom skills which he also pursued all of his life.

Bob is survived by his close friends and caregivers, Jo Ann Krause of Manistee, Candace (Krause) and her husband Paul Aksamitowski of Manistee, Kelly (Krause) Williams of Freesoil, MI, and Kevin and his wife Bobbie Krause of New Orleans, LA. Several cousins also survive him.

His brother Floyd Mikula also preceded Bob in death.
