

Suzanne Moby, age 88, an elder from the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians, suffered a stroke on March 19th, and assisted by the compassionate nurses from Hospice of Michigan she was allowed to pass peacefully at home on the 26th of March.

Born October 2, 1933 in Phelps, Wisconsin, she was the daughter of the late David Sr. and Eliza (Webb) Moby, youngest of five siblings who have all preceded her in death – Dorothy Anderson of East Jordan, Joseph Moby, Evelyn Cook and David Moby Jr. of Manistee.

Blind at birth, Suzie navigated thru life in the spirit realm, proving that God's grace was sufficient small in stature but mighty in prayer, this warrior added all to her list and prayed intensely for their suffering. A devout catholic her faith can best be described in one verse – John 20:29 "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed".
