In the Spring of 2025, our parish participated in the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) survey, provided to us by the Archdiocese of Atlanta in partnership with the Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI).

SURVEY FINDINGS

The results **identified both challenges & opportunities** faced by our parish, ultimately providing All Saints with insights to assist in developing a plan where we can thrive and be a place for others to grow together in faith. The collective input **indicates a parish in transition, marked by growing energy among younger families, liturgical renewal and a desire for deeper spiritual formation.**

92%

would **recommend our pastor to a friend**, indicating an appreciation for current pastoral leadership.

82%

say the **liturgy is one of our greatest strengths** – citing worship consistency, musical talent, and incorporation of greater beauty and reverence.

85%

perceive All Saints as **warm, welcoming, and community-oriented.**
