

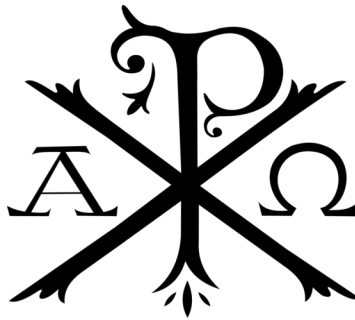

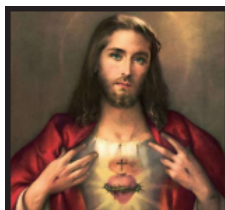

Core Themes of the Study

Innate Human Dignity: Explores the truth that a person's worth is a God-given gift rooted in creation, not something earned.

The "Feminine Genius": Highlights unique qualities like intuition, sensitivity, generosity, fidelity, and a profound capacity to prioritize persons over things.

Gratitude & Apology: Reflects on the Pope's gratitude for women in various roles (mothers, wives, workers, consecrated women) and his acknowledgment of historical societal injustices against women.

A Call to Action: Encourages women to transform culture and structural relationships through an authentic, loving presence.

Endow (Educating on the Nature and Dignity of Women) is a Catholic educational apostolate and small-group program. Rooted in the teachings of Pope St. John Paul II, it aims to help women discover their God-given dignity, understand the "feminine genius", and study the intellectual tradition of the Church through peer-led group discussions.

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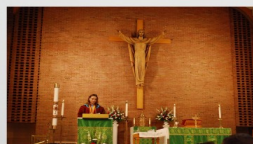

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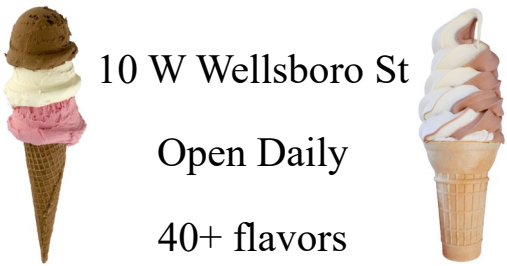
