Registration Process

The Office of Catechesis at Our Lady of the Holy Rosary St. Richard is pleased to announce that registration for the **2026/2027 Catechetical Year** is now open for HRSR School. The enrollment period begins **Saturday, August 26, 2026**, and will conclude on **Wednesday, September 30, 2026**.

Registration Instructions

To register, please visit our parish website at www.hrsrchurch.org. Under the **Sacraments** tab in the main menu, select **First Communion & Confirmation**. We kindly request that you review the information on that page in its entirety before proceeding to the registration link. Program Eligibility

Registration is currently open for the following candidates at a cost of \$50.00 per student:

- **Sacrament of First Holy Communion:** Students who have successfully completed Eucharist Supplemental course offered by a assigned HRSR School Teacher.
- **Sacrament of Confirmation:** Students who have successfully completed the Confirmation Supplemental course offered by a assigned HRSR School Teacher.

Legal Documents

Rights & Responsibilities

Baptismal Status: In accordance with the "Policy" section on page one, if the child is baptized Catholic, you are not strictly required to sign the initial policy acknowledgement.

Signature Requirements: As both parents are listed on the birth and baptismal certificates, the Parish requires signatures from both parties.

Legal Documentation: As noted on page two, if there are specific legal arrangements regarding the child's upbringing, the Parish may request that parents seek appropriate court instructions. We will fully respect and adhere to all lawful court orders. If such a document does not exist, signatures from both parents/guardians are mandatory.

Certificate of Eligibility

To be a Godparent/Sponsor is both an honor and an awesome responsibility, as it calls one to draw even deeper into the heart of Christ to gain wisdom in guiding the spiritual life of the candidate in the ways of Christ and His Church.

The Godparent/Sponsor, together with the Parents, must be willing to help the **Baptized/Confirmed** grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the Godparent/Sponsor will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it. (*cf. Code of Canon Law, can. 872*)

Church law permits Two Godparents for Baptism. Only one is necessary. If two are chosen, there must be one of each sex. Only one sponsor of either gender is permitted for Confirmation. (*cf. Code of Canon Law, can. 873*)

Certificates, Forms, Letter

Upload during the Registration process. If you received an email stating that the office needed a better quality or you did not upload during the Registration process, you MUST have documentation required no later than November 1st.

Mass Attendance

Mass attendance is maintained. **Students are expected to be in attendance as scheduled during the Catechetical school year and are required to attend regular Sunday Masses and Masses on *Holy Days of Obligation*.**

Upon arriving for Mass, you must bring a mass card with your Parish Registration 4-digit number, HRSR School Eucharist or Confirmation, your child's/children's name, date, and drop it in the offertory basket during Mass. Should you miss more than 14 masses throughout the School Year, your child will be in jeopardy of being withdrawn from the course and will have to repeat the class the following School Year. Or provide a signed bulletin from any **Roman Catholic Church, ONLY** that must be signed by the priest celebrating the mass, to verify mass attendance.

 - b. Copy of the Photo ID of both parents (in a PDF Format)
2. **Certificate of Eligibility for Godparents/Sponsors** signed and sealed by the Pastor/Administrator of the Parish in which the Godparent is registered and attends Mass.
3. **Baptism Course** completion by the Parents and the Godparents
 - a. Classes are on - Saturday, January 23 and Saturday, February 6 held in the Parish House at 10 AM
 - b. Online course, [Belonging/Pertenecer Baptism Course](#) - The week of September 23 - February 5
4. **Interview with Deacon or Priest**
5. **For separated or divorced parents**, must complete the **Archdiocese of Miami (ADOM) Policy Rights and Responsibilities of Parents/Guardians** form. We kindly request that you review and complete this document, returning the original signed version to our office for our permanent records.

7. **The bilingual Baptism Ceremony will be on April 3, 2027**
