History of The Holy Spirit “Field of Dreams”

On a late September evening in 2002, the Holy Spirit Field of Dreams ballpark was born. A corner lot of an old cotton field was designated for a baseball field. A conglomeration of ideas, people and interests came together. Genuine hard-working people began “doing the Lord’s work” donating their time, efforts and talents.

The Field of Dreams ball park is now a reality. Within just a few short years of conception, more than 40 boys and girls Little/Pony/Junior and soft ball league teams use the Field of Dreams ball park on a weekly basis. There is no charge for use of the field, only a promise to support it by helping maintain it and donating hole sponsor or field signs if possible.

Since the ballpark’s inception, a sprinkler system was installed along with fencing, back stops, a warm up area, grass, sod, trees, foul ball poles, dugouts, a bull pen, bleachers with canopies, field lights, shed were added. We recently completed our score board, concession and press box. We also requisitioned a fairway mower, special thanks to Daniel Castro. Now with the construction around the ball park fairly completed, we are in the process of finishing the landscaping and making continuous field improvements. We expanded the field to support 13U and junior league play.

The Annual Holy Spirit Two-Person Scramble is the sole fund raiser for the field. The tournament is held the at 8:00am on Saturday, July 25, 2026 at LakeRidge, and is now into its 28TH year. The ballpark is supported by the dedicated coaches, parents and volunteers who maintain the field. Importantly, this community ball park is made possible because of those who make a concerted effort to seeing such worthy community projects thrive.

TOURNAMENT RULES

FORMAT: Two-Person Scramble

1. USGA rules apply except to the extent modified by these rules.
2. You must use at least **one drive** from each member of the team.
3. Men will play with the white tee markers and Seniors and women from the red tee markers.
4. “Gimme” putts will be allowed “in the leather.”
5. Please repair all divots, ball marks and observe local club rules.
6. All **Ties** will be played off on the score card starting with a blind hole to be drawn by the tournament committee after play.
7. You may **improve your lie** in the fairway and in the rough one club length, not nearer the hole.
8. Prizes will be awarded on the top low gross teams and the top low net teams. (A team will **not** be eligible for both categories. The team’s **better** place of either category will be selected **first.**)
9. Teams shall record their gross (actual) score on each hole. The tournament committee will calculate net scores at the end of play.
10. 2 Mulligans may be purchased for \$10.00 per person (4 per team \$20.00). Mulligans may be used on par three holes, **but they will void any prize to be awarded on the hole as well as closest to the hole.**
11. Please turn in score cards **immediately** after play. CONTINUING PLAY AFTER THE ROUND IS COMPLETE WILL SUBJECT THE TEAM TO FORFEIT (we will have other teams waiting on your team to tally the scores)!
