Becoming Catholic - Order of Christian Initiation (OCIA)

The OCIA process is for adults and children, age 6 and over, who have never been baptized, have been baptized in another Christian faith, or have been baptized Catholic but have not had the opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Eucharist and/or Confirmation. Sunday morning preparation sessions (mid-September through Pentecost) focus on Scripture, teaching of the Church, prayer, and fostering a personal relationship with Christ through the community of the Church. The highlight of the journey is reception of the Sacraments at the Easter Vigil.

There are many opportunities to share your gifts in this process.

- Sponsor – journey with a candidate coming into the Church
- Children's Catechist – assist in instructing the children
- Small-Group Facilitator – discuss Catholic topics, share your experiences
- Presenter – teach a Catechetical lesson
- Hospitality – serve refreshments, assist with the Easter Vigil Reception

The Finance Council is an advisory group to the pastor with respect to policy and positions on matters pertaining to the financial management and planning aspects of the parish, including financial reporting, fundraising, budgeting, and cash management. Members are appointed for a three-year term.
