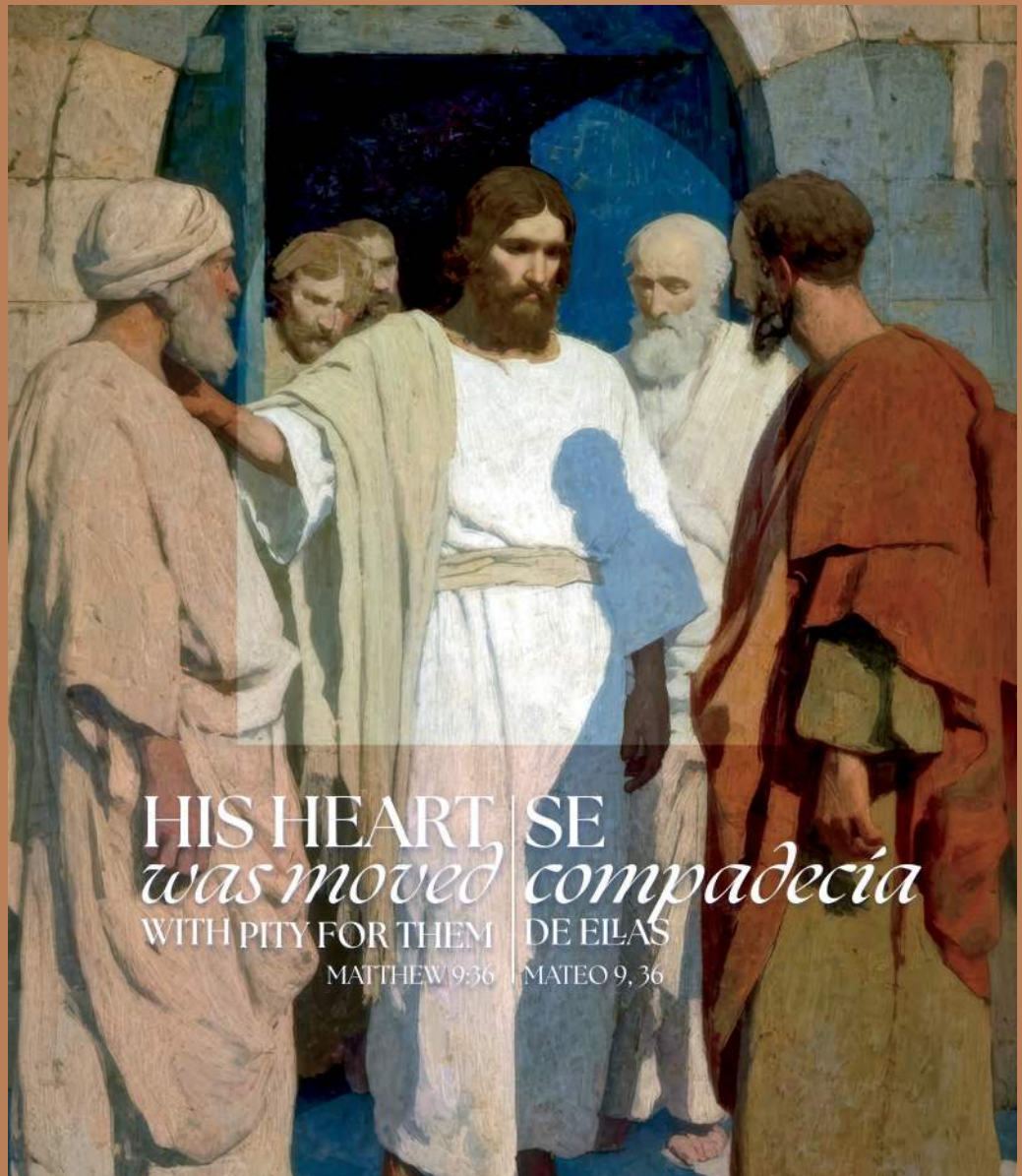

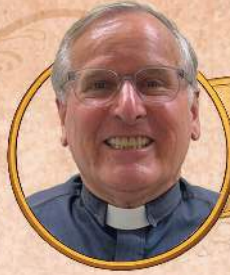

## Un Mensaje de Padre Tom

### Back to the good old days

2026 has proven to be the year of nostalgia. Youngsters are resorting to old-school tech like vintage flip phones and iPods. Others are returning to analog hobbies and activities. Even beloved restaurant chain Pizza Hut is going back in time, reverting to its retro glory — red checkered tablecloths, vinyl booths and Tiffany-style lamps. There is more. The beloved salad bar and red plastic cups will be back. Even the old-school Pac-Man machines will return. Unsurprisingly, customers are losing their minds over this massive change.

Well it seems to be working. It is not only Pizza Hut that is reviving its past. I see the same phenomenon in the Catholic Church. There is a return to the old tradition. The young priests make no apology in being theologically conservative. They prefer the cassock, Latin and the rosary. *It is spreading.* It is not just the clergy, but also evident among the laity. Kneeling for communion and receiving on the tongue was once a distant memory. It has made a startling come back. And it comes not without its critics. Some bishops discourage it or outright forbid it. I believe, that is not only going to remain, but prosper. We live in interesting times. Me? I am trying to figure out where I belong. I feel like I have feet in both worlds.

Something is going on. No one predicted this revival. The Spirit moves where the Spirit moves. If it is of the Holy spirit, I don't want to fight it. The church belongs to the young. I trust that they will take good care of it. After all, Jesus is in the house.

### Volviendo a los buenos tiempos de antaño

El 2026 ha demostrado ser el año de la nostalgia. Los jóvenes están recurriendo a tecnología de la vieja escuela, como los teléfonos plegables (\*flip phones\*) y los iPods de época. Otros están retomando aficiones y actividades analógicas. Incluso la querida cadena de restaurantes Pizza Hut está retrocediendo en el tiempo para recuperar su gloria de antaño: manteles de cuadros rojos, bancos de vinilo y lámparas estilo Tiffany. Y hay más: volverán la popular barra de ensaladas y los vasos de plástico rojo. Incluso regresarán las máquinas de Pac-Man clásicas. Como era de esperar, los clientes están entusiasmados con este gran cambio.

Pues parece que está funcionando. Pizza Hut no es la única que está reviviendo su pasado. Observo el mismo fenómeno en la Iglesia Católica. Hay un retorno a la antigua tradición. Los sacerdotes jóvenes no se disculpan por ser teológicamente conservadores; prefieren la sotana, el latín y el rosario. *Es una tendencia que se extiende.* No se limita al clero, sino que también es evidente entre los laicos. Arrodillarse para recibir la comunión y hacerlo en la lengua había quedado como un recuerdo lejano, pero ha protagonizado un regreso sorprendente. Y esto no está exento de críticas: algunos obispos lo desaconsejan o incluso lo prohíben rotundamente. Creo que esta práctica no solo perdurará, sino que prosperará. Vivimos tiempos interesantes. ¿Y yo? Intento averiguar dónde encajo; siento que tengo un pie en cada mundo.

Algo está sucediendo. Nadie predijo este resurgimiento. El Espíritu se mueve donde quiere. Si proviene del Espíritu Santo, no quiero oponerme a ello. La Iglesia pertenece a los jóvenes. Confío en que la cuidarán bien. Al fin y al cabo, Jesús está presente.
