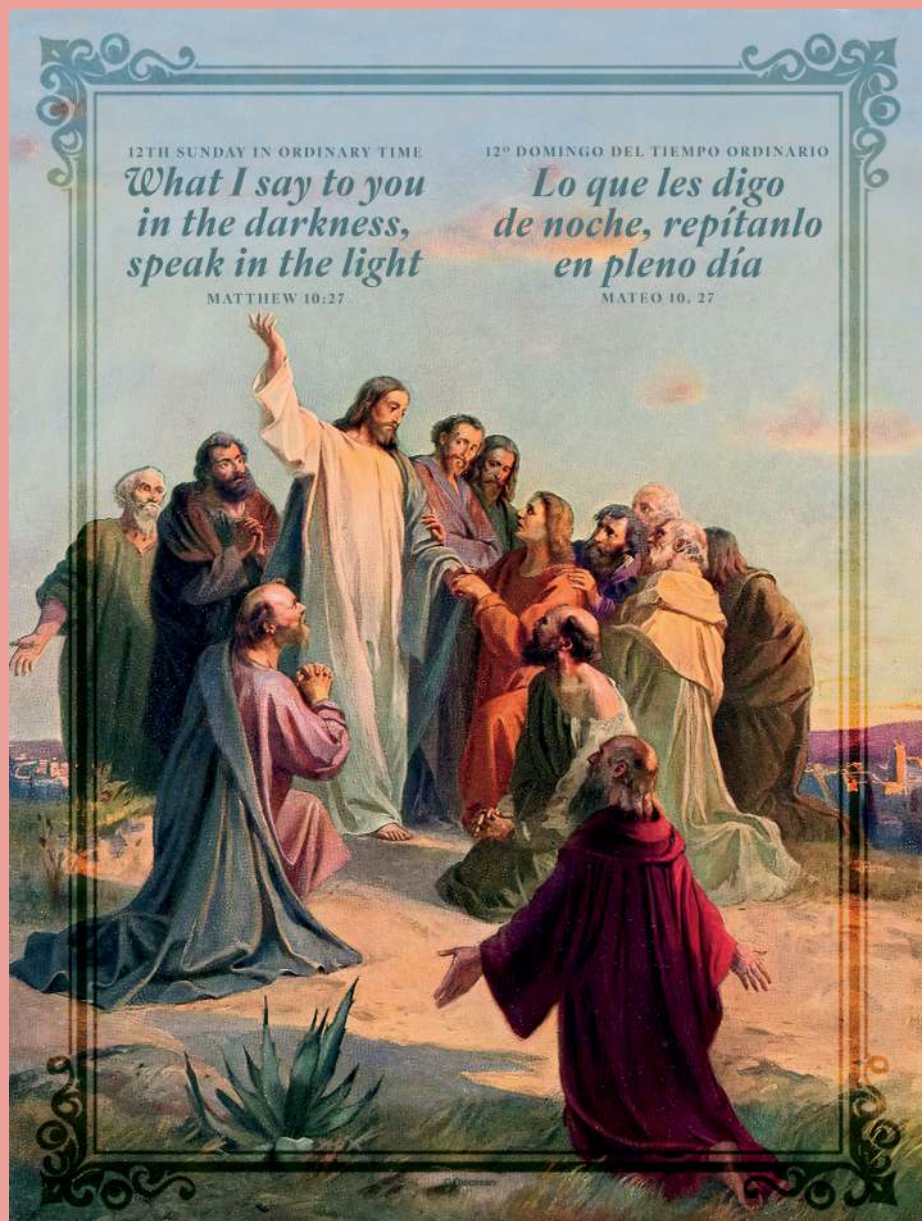

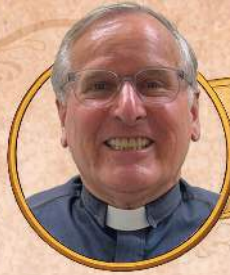

*Chuck and I enjoyed meeting you this past Tuesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>. Rosie had been encouraging us to come and see how wonderful the meal service and pantry are for several months. But, like so many things in life, experiencing something in person transcends just hearing about it. We were blown away by the facility, the huge team, the teamwork itself, the amount of organization involved, the number of folks served, and the attitudes of all the volunteers! Your hands are full overseeing this amazing operation!*

*That you took time amid the hustle and bustle of the morning's activities to give me such an in-depth, informative guided tour of the pantry system was such a blessing! But your knowledge – sourcing and storing the food, hows/whys of distribution to those needing it, thoughts behind the "homeless" bag goods, etc. – that was invaluable insight helping me become a better partner for the Dunnellon Program.*

*We aren't strangers to homelessness as our son passed away, alone, on a bench four winters ago, after decades of mental illness, drugs and prison, and a granddaughter (our daughter's oldest) has been struggling with the same issues now for 15 years. Behind each face is a real story of paths trodden where my own feet have not actually stepped. Channeling your knowledge and experience will, hopefully, allow us to make a drop of difference.*

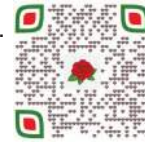
## Welcoming New Catholics Are Your Family or Friends Among Them?

## NEW CATHOLIC CEMETERY OPENS IN THE VILLAGES!!!

Our Lady of the Holy Rosary is a vast 60-acre property. Its first phase includes more than 2,000 full body burial sites, the air-conditioned Lumen Christi Columbarium, 140 above ground granite burial sites, 46 private estates, and an administration building. The cemetery is designed in the shape of a rosary.

Bishop John Noonan cut the ribbon inaugurating the cemetery, April 28, 2026, and blessed the grounds and buildings. Our Lady of the Holy Rosary Cemetery in Oxford is open, by appointment only. A public grand opening will be announced soon.
