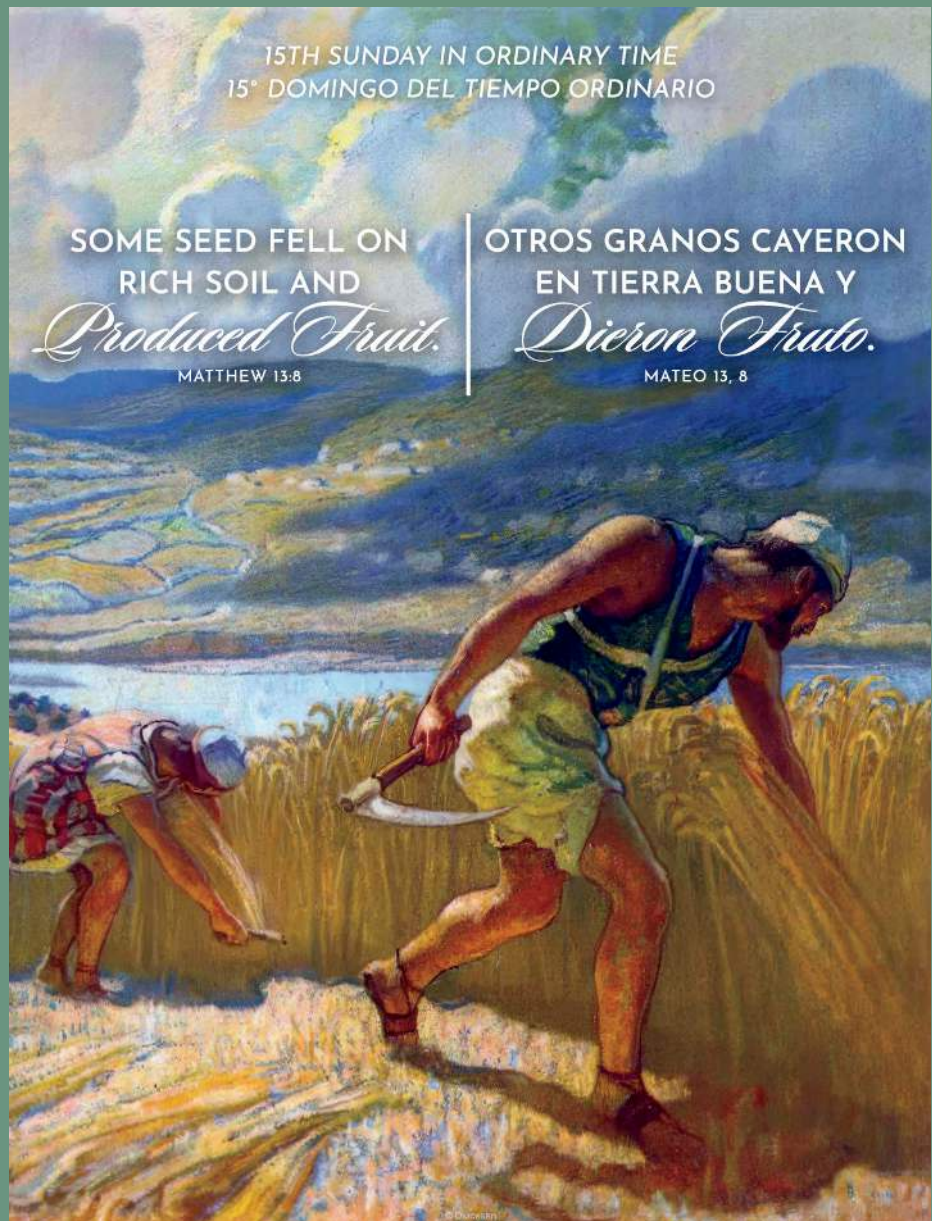

I came across this blurb and think it may be of some help. Check it out.

Four Simple Habits That Can Change Your Life

I'm gonna give you four stupidly simple habits that can fix 90% of your problems.

All right, Number One: sleep on it before you respond to anything that pushes your button. Most of the worst decisions people make happen when they're being overly emotional. But if you give yourself 24 hours, you will be shocked at how many fires put themselves out.

Number Two: ask yourself if you're hungry, tired, or lonely before deciding if a problem is real. I'm kind of laughing because this is ridiculous, but seriously, half the time you think there's a big crisis going on, you might just need a sandwich and a nap.

Number Three: get outside every single day, even if it's just for 10 minutes; not even for exercise, just for your brain. Sunlight movement is basically natural anti-depressants that nobody prescribes because there's no money in it.

Number Four: say what you actually mean instead of hinting and hoping that people figure it out. The amount of drama that exists in the world because someone expected somebody else to read their mind is absolutely staggering.

Now, none of these are exciting, none of these will go viral, but most of your problems - the stupid arguments and the spiraling and the awkward attention - they come from being reactive, depleted, or unclear. So, if you fix those four things, you can watch 90% of your drama disappear.

There you are. Try it. Though not mentioned, I would like to add a fifth habit: Daily Prayer. God's grace and inspiration can calm, soothe and heal. It brings peace and purpose and connects us to our God who loves us. No problem is greater than that!

Cuatro hábitos sencillos que pueden cambiar tu vida

Voy a darte cuatro hábitos increíblemente simples que pueden solucionar el 90% de tus problemas.

Muy bien, el primero: deja pasar la noche antes de responder a cualquier cosa que te haga saltar o te irrite. La mayoría de las peores decisiones que toma la gente ocurren cuando están demasiado alterados emocionalmente. Pero si te das un plazo de 24 horas, te sorprenderá ver cuántos "incendios" se apagan solos.

El segundo: pregúntate si tienes hambre, sueño o te sientes solo antes de decidir si un problema es real. Me hace un poco de gracia porque suena ridículo, pero en serio: la mitad de las veces que crees que hay una gran crisis, puede que solo necesites un sándwich y una siesta.

El tercero: sal al aire libre todos los días, aunque sea solo 10 minutos; no hace falta que sea para hacer ejercicio, basta con que sea por el bien de tu cerebro. La luz del sol y el movimiento actúan básicamente como antidepresivos naturales que nadie receta porque no generan dinero.

El cuarto: di lo que realmente piensas en lugar de lanzar indirectas y esperar que los demás lo adivinen. La cantidad de drama que existe en el mundo porque alguien esperaba que otra persona le leyera la mente es absolutamente asombrosa.

Ninguno de estos hábitos es emocionante ni se hará viral, pero la mayoría de tus problemas —las discusiones absurdas, los pensamientos que se descontrolan y las situaciones incómodas— surgen de actuar de forma reactiva, estar agotado o no tener las ideas claras. Así que, si corriges esos tres aspectos, verás cómo desaparece el 90% de tu drama.

Ahí lo tienes. Pruébalo. Aunque no se mencionaba en el texto original, me gustaría añadir un quinto hábito: la oración diaria. La gracia y la inspiración de Dios pueden calmar, reconfortar y sanar. Aportan paz y propósito, y nos conectan con el Dios que nos ama. ¡Ningún problema es mayor que eso!

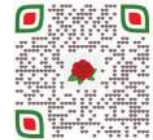
Welcoming New Catholics Are Your Family or Friends Among Them?
