Yes, there is a Wawa by my sister's house. I can get my Thursday breakfast burrito.

Monday, I take my family and my mom's friends to lunch. It is our new tradition. They were very kind to my mom when she was ill. We are having Italian!

Sunday the 19th is National Ice Cream Day, I will celebrate accordingly!

You will see my old classmate Fr. John at mass on Sunday.

I will be back soon. No worries, Mrs. Faye and staff have it all under control.

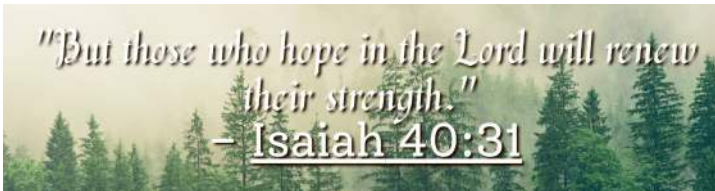
