A Message from Fr. Tom
Un Mensaje de Padre Tom

As I ate dinner, I was watching a YouTube video. Father Casey Cole a Franciscan friar and host of Breaking in the Habit podcast, was being interviewed by Protestant Pastor Erik Huffman on his *Maybe God* podcast. It was quite an engaging episode, titled "Catholic vs Protestant: The Pope, Salvation, and the Eucharist". They dealt with key theological differences and common misconceptions between their traditions. Most importantly, they spoke with mutual respect for each other. There was no name calling, criticism or shouting - just a sincere, mature conversation. They did this while not denying, overlooking or ignoring our differences.

In the conversation, Pastor Huffman was struggling to remember Fr. Mike Schmitz's last name. He couldn't remember. So that there was no doubt to which Fr. Mike he was talking about, he blurted out what first came to mind - "Handsome Father Mike". I chuckled. I never heard a priest identified by their degree of good looks. The nickname works. It is fitting and it sort of flows off the tongue - "Handsome Father Mike". It is catchy. You can call his office:

"Hi, I'd like to speak to Father Mike"
 "Which Father Mike?"
 "Handsome Father Mike"
 "Hold on; I will transfer you"
Maybe by accident she transfers you to the wrong Fr. Mike
 "Hi. Handsome Father Mike?"
 "I'm sorry you got the wrong Father Mike. I am the Ugly Father Mike"
 "Oh, Sorry."
 "No problem. Happens all the time."

Here is a good question - What would be the one adjective that describes you? Oh look there is Kind Kelly, or Patient Paul, perhaps Generous George. I would hate if they knew us as Crabby Carl, Angry Andy, or Lazy Lily. **You can influence how people will think of you by living that life now.** Be joyful, be helpful, be giving. People will notice. It may not be as catchy as "Handsome Father Mike" but certainly more important. Kindness outweighs good looks. God bless you and God bless "Handsome Father Mike" who does great job spreading the Word.

Mientras cenaba, estaba viendo un video de YouTube. El padre Casey Cole, fraile franciscano y presentador del podcast "Breaking in the Habit", estaba siendo entrevistado por el pastor protestante Erik Huffman en su podcast "Maybe God". Fue un episodio muy interesante, titulado "Católico vs. Protestante: El Papa, la salvación y la Eucaristía". Abordaron diferencias teológicas clave y conceptos erróneos comunes entre sus tradiciones. Lo más importante es que hablaron con respeto mutuo. No hubo insultos, críticas ni gritos; solo una conversación sincera y madura. Lo hicieron sin negar, pasar por alto ni ignorar nuestras diferencias.

Durante la charla, al pastor Huffman le costaba recordar el apellido del padre Mike Schmitz. No lo lograba. Así que, para que no hubiera dudas sobre a qué padre Mike se refería, soltó lo primero que le vino a la mente: "el apuesto padre Mike". Me reí entre dientes. Nunca había oído a un sacerdote identificado por su atractivo físico. El apodo funciona. Es apropiado y suena bien al decirlo: "el apuesto padre Mike". Es pegadizo. Podrías llamar a su oficina:

"Hola, quisiera hablar con el padre Mike"
 "¿Qué padre Mike?"
 "El apuesto padre Mike".
 "Espere un momento, le paso la llamada".
Tal vez, por error, te comuniquen con el padre Mike equivocado.
 "Hola, ¿el apuesto padre Mike?"
 "Lo siento, se ha comunicado con el padre Mike equivocado. Yo soy el padre Mike feo".
 "Oh, lo siento".
 "No hay problema. Pasa todo el tiempo".

Aquí hay una buena pregunta: ¿cuál sería el adjetivo que te describiría? Mira, ahí está Kelly la Amable, o Paul el Paciente, o tal vez George el Generoso. No me gustaría que nos conocieran como Carl el Gruñón, Andy el Enojón o Lily la Perezosa. **Puedes influir en cómo piensa la gente de ti viviendo esa vida ahora mismo.** Sé alegre, servicial y generoso. La gente lo notará. Puede que no sea tan pegadizo como "el apuesto padre Mike", pero sin duda es más importante. La amabilidad vale más que el buen aspecto físico. Que Dios te bendiga y que Dios bendiga al "apuesto padre Mike", quien hace un gran trabajo difundiendo la Palabra.

How Perfect Our Imperfections!

I tend to dwell on mistakes I've made, replaying what happened and what I could have done differently. And while it's important to reflect on the errs of my ways, it's not healthy to beat myself up – which is what ends up happening when I dwell for too long. I've learned I'm not alone. We often kick ourselves and dwell on our mistakes, replaying our missteps and the times we've put our foot in our mouth. Yet we are not called to remain there. We are called to pick ourselves up, dust ourselves off, and continue forward. What I've also noticed is that it's often another's outstretched hand that helps me get back up. And the dust we brush off is often shared with others who understand our struggles because they have walked a similar road.

It is in those moments of imperfection that leaning on the Lord has guided me through the mishap, my faux pas, and, sometimes, my foolishness. When I lean on Him, I am reminded of His grace and mercy. How wonderfully ironic that His mercy and grace is often offered through the Spirit of another's outstretched hand. Then I can look at my flaws, and I am reminded that I am God's handiwork—a work in progress. I am not called to perfection but to transformation, striving each day to become more like Jesus. Seeing ourselves and others through God's eyes helps us recognize the dignity and worth He has placed within every person.

We are, after all, made in His image and likeness. At times, that truth can seem unfathomable. How can each of us—so different in appearance, personality, talents, and circumstances—be made in His image? Really? Even those we perceive as difficult and unkind? Yet Scripture reminds us that God knew us before we were born and knows even the number of hairs on our heads. His knowledge of us is complete, and His love is unwavering.

And as we journey through our own trials, we should never underestimate the impact we can have on others. Our imperfections help us understand another's. Our words and actions can encourage, inspire, and help someone persevere through their own hardships. Our strength can help carry another's burden and lighten their load.

¿Qué perfectas son nuestras imperfecciones!

Suelo darle muchas vueltas a los errores que he cometido, reviviendo lo que sucedió y lo que podría haber hecho de otra manera. Y, aunque es importante reflexionar sobre mis faltas, no es saludable castigarme a mí misma, que es lo que termina ocurriendo cuando me quedo atrapada en esos pensamientos durante demasiado tiempo. He aprendido que no estoy sola. A menudo nos recriminamos y nos obsesionamos con nuestros errores, repasando nuestros tropiezos y aquellas ocasiones en las que metimos la pata. Sin embargo, no estamos llamados a quedarnos ahí. Estamos llamados a levantarnos, sacudirnos el polvo y seguir adelante. También he notado que, con frecuencia, es la mano tendida de otra persona la que me ayuda a ponerme en pie de nuevo. Y ese polvo que nos sacudimos a menudo se comparte con otros que comprenden nuestras luchas, porque ellos también han recorrido un camino similar.

Es en esos momentos de imperfección donde apoyarme en el Señor me ha guiado a través de los contratiempos, mis meteduras de pata y, a veces, mis insensateces. Cuando me apoyo en Él, recuerdo su gracia y su misericordia. ¡Qué maravillosa ironía que su misericordia y su gracia se ofrezcan a menudo a través de la mano tendida de otra persona! Entonces puedo mirar mis defectos y recordar que soy obra de las manos de Dios: una obra en constante evolución. No estoy llamada a la perfección, sino a la transformación, esforzándome cada día por parecerme más a Jesús. Vernos a nosotros mismos y a los demás con los ojos de Dios nos ayuda a reconocer la dignidad y el valor que Él ha depositado en cada persona.

Al fin y al cabo, hemos sido creados a su imagen y semejanza. A veces, esa verdad puede parecer incomprensible. ¿Cómo es posible que cada uno de nosotros —tan diferentes en apariencia, personalidad, talentos y circunstancias— hayamos sido creados a su imagen? ¿De verdad? ¿Incluso aquellos a quienes percibimos como personas difíciles o desagradables? Sin embargo, las Escrituras nos recuerdan que Dios nos conocía antes de que nacióramos y sabe incluso cuántos cabellos tenemos en la cabeza. Su conocimiento sobre nosotros es absoluto y su amor, inquebrantable.

Y, al atravesar nuestras propias pruebas, nunca debemos subestimar el impacto que podemos tener en los demás. Nuestras imperfecciones nos ayudan a comprender las de los demás. Nuestras palabras y acciones pueden animar, inspirar y ayudar a alguien a perseverar en medio de sus propias dificultades. Nuestra fortaleza puede ayudar a sobrellevar la carga de otra persona y hacerla más ligera.

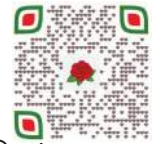
Welcoming New Catholics Are Your Family or Friends Among Them?
