Water Bottles

Please help your child come to school with a water bottle that meets the following guidelines:

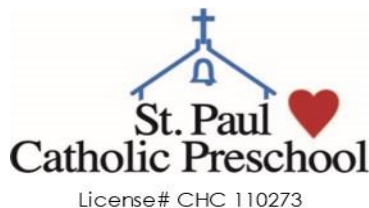
- Label the water bottle with your child's **first and last name** (required by DCF Licensing).
- Water bottles should be **9 inches tall or shorter**.
- If the bottle has a **straw or spout**, it must have a **cover or flip-top lid** to keep it protected when not in use.
- A **handle is preferred** to make it easier for children to carry their water bottle independently.
- Please see the photos below for examples of **preferred water bottle styles**.



NOT Recommended

- Water bottles **taller than 9 inches**.
- Water bottles with an **uncovered/open straw or spout**.
- The water bottle styles shown in the "**Not Recommended**" photos below.
