Public Square Rosary Rally

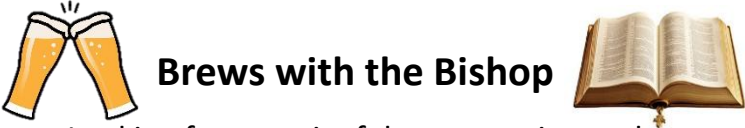
On October 13, 1917, Our Lady performed the

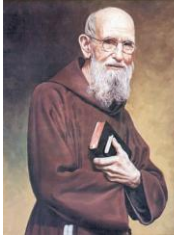
