Wedding Music Policy

- Our Wedding Music Coordinator will schedule a meeting around three months before the wedding to plan the music with you. The planning and approval of all selected music is the responsibility of the Wedding Music Coordinator.
- The Wedding Music Coordinator plays at the wedding, or provides a suitable substitute, and hires the cantor.
- The Wedding Music Coordinator must approve or can assist you in hiring (optional) additional instrumentalists. A separate fee is paid directly to them.
- The Wedding Music Coordinator must approve any outside musicians to provide the music *in addition to* the parish musicians. If an additional rehearsal is required, though rare, the fee of \$125 may be paid directly to the wedding music coordinator.
- The Wedding Music Coordinator must approve any outside musicians to provide the music *instead of* the parish musicians – be prepared to explain the wedding couple's connection to the proposed substitution.
- The Wedding Music Coordinator will communicate solely with the bride and groom for wedding music planning.
- No recorded music may be used in the church before, during, or after the wedding.
